Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

K. H. Lee earned 500 FedExCup points with his first career PGA TOUR win at the 2021 AT&T Byron Nelson. In his 80th career PGA TOUR start, K.H. Lee becomes the ninth of 12 players to make their first PGA TOUR win at the AT&T Byron Nelson in 60 or more starts.

- 25** Finishing 25-under par, K.H. Lee records the lowest 72-hole Score to Par at the AT&T Byron Nelson (since 1983).
- 25** K.H. Lee posted a career best 25 under par for an event on TOUR, his 25-under was his career best by seven shots over his 18-under at the 2021 WMPO.
- 5th** K.H. was ranked fifth Greens in Regulation, marking the fifth winner of the AT&T Byron Nelson to be ranked inside the Top-10 in the past six years

- 58** K.H. Lee hit 58 Greens in Regulation at the 2021 AT&T Byron Nelson, marking his fourth most in an event
- 28** K.H. Lee had 28 birdies at the 2021 AT&T Byron Nelson, marking the most in an event on TOUR in his career

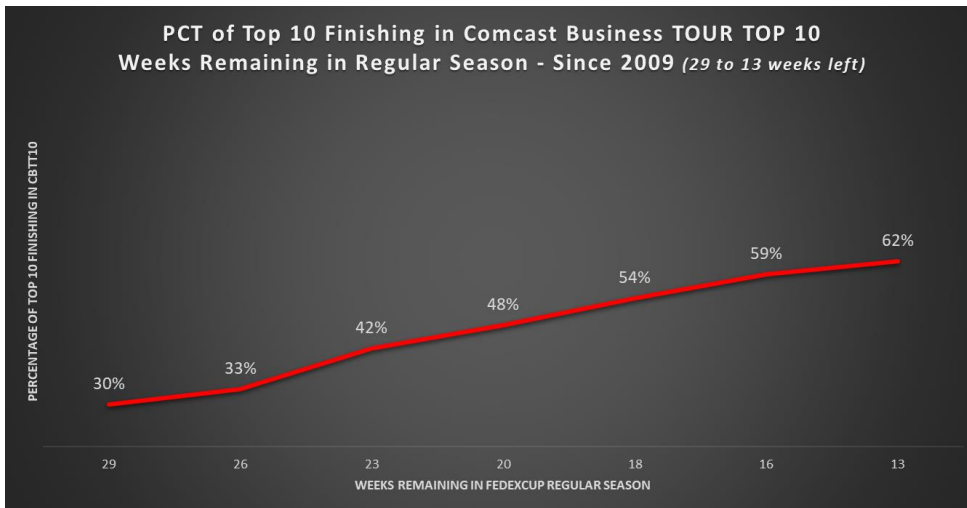

Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 & FedExCup Storylines

- 6th** Max Homa moved from 20th to Sixth in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10, his 20th career week ranked in the TOUR TOP 10 (18th week this season, two last season). Seeks first season qualifying for the TOUR Championship.
- 100%** Each of the last five seasons, the player sixth in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 has finished the FedExCup Regular Season in the TOUR TOP 10
- 5th** Homa is the fifth player to win multiple times this season, joining Scheffler (4), Burns (2), C. Smith (2) and Matsuyama (2). This season marks the most multiple winners at this point in a season since 2009 (13 weeks left in FEC regular season)
- 62%** Since 2009, 62% of the players in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 with 13 weeks remaining have finished in the final Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 (81 of 130)
