**Today** – Broken cloud cover pushing in from the northwest will gradually erode this morning, becoming sunny to mostly sunny for the afternoon. Southerly winds will increase to 10-17 mph in the afternoon, with gusts of 18-23 mph after 1-2pm. A few thunderstorms may become possible overnight.

**Tonight/tomorrow** – A few thunderstorms are possible overnight as a weakening complex drifts southward out of Oklahoma. Expect the highest chances will occur between 1-4am before this activity slides off to the south and east. Should the McKinney area get hit by a cell or two overnight expect that rainfall of 0.10" to 0.25" would occur. Additionally, an isolated strong thunderstorm wind gust of 30-40 mph will be possible overnight. Monday will see a mix of sun and clouds gradually become partly cloudy. Breezy east-northeasterly winds are expected to arrive by 10am. The temperature will reach a high in the upper 80s.
