Extended forecast – Friday will see breezy southerly winds after 11am along with a 10% chance of a pop-up shower or thunderstorm after 4pm. There is a low (10-15%) chance that a weak frontal boundary in Oklahoma will set off a few thunderstorms north of the area Friday night that may drift into North Texas during the early morning hours on Saturday – but expect that any such activity would be brief should it reach the Metroplex. Additionally, a low coverage of showers and thunderstorms may develop after 2pm Saturday afternoon. There will be very slim (5-10%) chance of a pop-up shower or thunderstorm after 3pm on Sunday.
