Things to Know

- Tom Hoge holds the outright 18-hole lead for the first time in his PGA TOUR career (0-for-6 with the 18-hole co-lead)
- Hoge’s 63 marks the third-lowest score of his PGA TOUR career (62 twice)
- Reigning FedExCup Champion Patrick Cantlay stands T5 after a 6-under 65 at Monterey Peninsula Country Club

- 6 First-round leaders/co-leaders to win the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am since 2000 (most recent: Nick Taylor, 2020)
- 1 First-round leaders/co-leaders to win on TOUR in 2021-22 (Cameron Smith, Sentry Tournament of Champions)

- 9-under 63, the third-lowest score of his PGA TOUR career (lowest: 62, 2015 and 2020 Wyndham Championship)
- Starting on No. 10, made six consecutive birdies on Nos. 3-8, the longest birdie streak of his PGA TOUR career (previous: 5, twice; most recent: 2021 Valero Texas Open)
- Holds the outright first-round lead for the first time in his career; 0-for-6 when holding the 18-hole co-lead on TOUR and did not finish in the top 25 in any of those instances (most recent: 2020 Wyndham Championship/T27)
- Seeking first PGA TOUR title (best finish: 2nd/2019 A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier, 2nd/2022 American Express)
- T2 entering the final round of the 2021 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am before finishing 12th, his best result in seven previous starts at the event

Miscellaneous Notes

- Seamus Power (2nd/-8/SH) is making his fifth start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, with his best result coming in 2020 (T38); Power earned his first career PGA TOUR victory last season at the Barbasol Championship and has two top-fives in nine starts this season (T4/The RSM Classic, T3/Sony Open in Hawaii)
- PGA TOUR rookie **Austin Smotherman**, who competed at Pebble Beach as a junior participant in the 2015 PURE Insurance Championship, stands T3 (-7/PB); Smotherman made eagles at Nos. 18 and 6, the first two eagles of his PGA TOUR career
- Reigning FedExCup Champion **Patrick Cantlay** (T5/-6/MP) opened with a 65; Cantlay, who finished T3 at the event in 2021, has two top-10s in two starts this season (4th/Sentry Tournament of Champions, 9th/The American Express)
- Two-time champions **Kevin Streelman** and Larry Fitzgerald lead the pro-am portion of the competition at 11-under
