Daniel Berger earned his fourth career PGA TOUR victory in his 152nd career start at the 2021 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

- 4** Daniel Berger made four eagles this week, marking his career most in an event on TOUR, the most by a winner at this event and the fourth player to make four eagles in a week at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am since 1983
- 1st** In the final round, Daniel Berger led the field in Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green (+3.53), eagles (2), Proximity to the Hole (20' 8") and lowest score (65).
- 2** Berger was one of two players who made birdie or better on every par 5 in the Final Round (Max Homa) and played the par 5s in six under. Berger averaged 10' 7" closer than the field in proximity to the hole on approach shots in the final round.

- 10** The winner of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am has ranked inside the top 10 for Greens in Regulation in each of the last 10 years (since 2012)
- 33** Since 1983, the winner of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am has been inside the top 10 of the leaderboard after 54 holes in 33 of 34 editions of this event (72-hole event). The only player to come from outside the top 10 after 54 holes and win was Davis Love III (2001).
