#### Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 & FedExCup Storylines

- 3 Three of six winners at the Barbasol Championship have qualified for the BMW Championship
- 22 Scott Piercy (2015 / 22<sup>nd</sup>) only Barbasol Championship winner to qualify for the TOUR Championship
- **0** No change to the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 last week at TPC Deere Run
- percentage of the players in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 with five weeks remaining finished in the final Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 (102 of 130). In the last 13 seasons, 100% of players fifth or better in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 at this point in the season went onto finish in the final Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 of the regular season.
- 28.5 The Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 with five weeks left in the FedExCup regular season have a combined average age of 28.5, the third consecutive season with the average age under 30 at this point in the season
- Justin Thomas has ranked inside the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 with five weeks left in the FedExCup Regular Season six times since the 2015-16 season, two more than any other player
- points separate 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings, the second largest difference with five weeks left in a FedExCup Regular season since 2009
