Things to Know

- When holding a 54-hole lead/co-lead, Chez Reavie has converted for the win both occasions on the PGA TOUR
- Reavie seeks to become the first player 40 or older to win on TOUR this season
- Martin Laird trails by six points after a 13-point performance in the third round
- Making his 132nd PGA TOUR start, Alex Noren would become the event’s seventh straight first-time winner, the longest active streak on TOUR

Scoring

The Barracuda Championship is employing the Modified Stableford scoring format, the first PGA TOUR event to use the format since The International in 2006. Players are allocated points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole with the goal of achieving the highest overall score.

- Leads by six points, matching the largest 54-hole lead at the Barracuda Championship since the event moved to Modified Stableford scoring format (Parker McLachlin/2008)
- Remains the only player bogey-free through 54 holes

- Lone bogey through 54 holes came during round three on the par-3 15th hole
- Holds third career 54-hole lead/co-lead on PGA TOUR; 2-for-2 to date converting to victory (2008 RBC Canadian Open, 2019 Travelers Championship)
- At 40 years, 8 months, 5 days, would become the first player aged 40 or older to win on TOUR this season and first since Lucas Glover at the 2021 John Deere Classic
- Making fifth start at the Barracuda Championship (best: T42/2009)
- Holds two top 10 finishes in 23 starts this season: T10/The Genesis Invitational, T8/Travelers Championship
- Has reached the FedExCup Playoffs nine times, including the last six; ended the 2020-21 season No. 104 in the FedExCup

Additional Notes

- **Martin Laird** (2nd/+31) trails by six points after a 13-point performance in the third round; seeks fifth PGA TOUR win and first since 2020 Shriners Children's Open
- In search of first PGA TOUR victory, **Alex Noren** (T3/+28) would become the Barracuda Championship's seventh straight first-time winner, the longest active streak on TOUR; four of his 10 DP World Tour wins have been come-from-behind victories (most recent: 2018 Open de France)
- **Joshua Creel** (T7/+26) seeks to become the second-consecutive player to win in his Barracuda Championship debut (Erik van Rooyen/2021)
- **Charley Hoffman** (T13/+24) is one of six players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in each season since the inception in 2007; currently outside the top 125 at No. 182 in the FedExCup standings
