#### Things to Know

- Chez Reavie wins the Barracuda Championship by one point to earn his third PGA TOUR victory and first since 2019
- The 40-year-old becomes the oldest winner on TOUR this season
- In search of his first PGA TOUR title, Alex Noren finishes runner-up for the second time in his 132<sup>nd</sup> career start
- As part of the Strategic Alliance with the PGA TOUR and DP World Tour, the field included the top 50 available players from the DP World Tour priority ranking

#### Scoring

The Barracuda Championship is employing the Modified Stableford scoring format, the first PGA TOUR event to use the format since The International in 2006. Players are allocated points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole with the goal of achieving the highest overall score.

- Earns his third PGA TOUR title in his 361st start (2008 RBC Canadian Open, 2019 Travelers Championship)
- With the win, collects 300 FedExCup points and is fully exempt on PGA TOUR and DP World Tour through the end of 2024
- Moves from No. 101 to No. 49 in the FedExCup standings
- At 40 years, 8 months, 5 days, becomes the oldest winner on TOUR this season and first player in his 40s to win on TOUR since Lucas Glover (2021 John Deere Classic)
- Improves to a perfect 3-for-3 with the 54-hole lead/co-lead and 2-for-4 with the 36-hole lead/co-lead
- Becomes the 13th third-round leader/co-leader to win the Barracuda Championship
- Victory comes in fifth Barracuda Championship start
- Marks third top 10 finish of the season: T10/The Genesis Invitational, T8/Travelers Championship

**Additional Notes**

- In search of first PGA TOUR victory in his 132nd start, **Alex Noren** (2nd/+42) finishes runner-up for the second time (T2/2018 Farmers Insurance Open); was seeking to become the first Swedish winner on TOUR since Henrik Stenson at the 2017 Wyndham Championship
- Playing in the final pairing of the day, **Martin Laird** (3rd/+38) earns best career finish since his win at the 2020 Shriners' Children's Open
- In attempt to become the Barracuda Championship's seventh straight first-time winner, **Mark Hubbard** (4<sup>th</sup>/+37) collects fifth career top-10 finish and second in as many weeks (3rd/Barbasol Championship)
- With a fifth-place result, **Scott Gutschewski** posts career-best finish in his 133<sup>rd</sup> start (previous: T6/2006 B.C. Open)
