TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

Year three: The Butterfield Bermuda Championship is a third-year PGA TOUR event and for the second time serves as a standalone event due to the cancellation of the World Golf Championships-HSBC Champions. As a result, the winner will receive full FedExCup points (500).

Bermuda is one of seven countries/territories hosting at least one of the nine PGA TOUR events outside the United States this season.

Brian Gay in Bermuda: Brian Gay looks to successfully defend his 2020 Butterfield Bermuda Championship title. Gay made birdie at the 72nd hole in 2020 to force a playoff with Wyndham Clark and made a 15-foot birdie putt to win on the first extra hole. Gay, whose win was the fifth of his PGA TOUR career, also finished T3 in 2019.

At 48 years, 10 months, 18 days, Gay became the oldest winner on the PGA TOUR since Davis Love III at the 2015 Wyndham Championship and was one of six players age 40 or older to win on TOUR in 2020-21 (oldest: Phil Mickelson, PGA Championship).

Season debut for Bezuidenhout: World No. 43 Christiaan Bezuidenhout is making his first start as a PGA TOUR member; with his joining for this season, everyone in the top 50 of the Official World Golf Ranking is a TOUR member.

Last attempt for Knous: Jim Knous is making his final start on his medical extension and needs 91.063 FedExCup points (3-way T6 or better) to play out of the Major Medical Extension category for the remainder of the season or 3.516 points (solo-67th or better) to play out of the 126-150 category for the remainder of the season. If he finishes worse than solo-67th, he will lose PGA TOUR membership and play on the Korn Ferry Tour.

FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

Last time out: Hideki Matsuyama won the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, the lone PGA TOUR event in his home country of Japan, by five strokes to earn his seventh TOUR title. The victory marked his second TOUR win in Asia and first since the 2016 World Golf Championships-HSBC Champions.

Top 50 winners: A player entering the week inside the top 50 in the Official World Golf Ranking has won in all five weeks during the 2021-22 season, the longest streak to start a season since 2005 (first 10 weeks*). There are three players in the field ranked in the top 50: No. 24 Patrick Reed, No. 26 Matt Fitzpatrick and No. 43 Christiaan Bezuidenhout.

Local Bermudian Brian Morris, who suffers from terminal stage IV cancer and serves as the head golf professional at Ocean View Golf Club, is making his PGA TOUR debut on a sponsor exemption.

2021 Walker Cup teammates Austin Eckroat and John Pak, who have since turned professional, and Texas Tech's Ludvig Aberg, the world's third-ranked amateur, are set to compete on sponsor exemptions. Pak will make his eighth start and Eckroat will make his ninth, while Aberg, of Sweden, will make his PGA TOUR debut.
