High clouds, streaming from the west, may make it mostly cloudy at times this afternoon as well. The wind will be lighter than previous days out of the northwest 10-15 gusting to 20 mph.

Extended forecast – High pressure will quickly move east Saturday as strong low-pressure system develops over the Eastern U.S. and moves a cold front towards Bermuda on Saturday. Showers will be possible Saturday afternoon into evening as a warm front lifts through the region. Scattered showers Sunday morning will increase in coverage with rain and a few thunderstorms becoming likely during the afternoon as the cold front moves across Bermuda. The rain could be heavy at times, especially with any storms. Finally, this system will move east of Bermuda allowing drier conditions to return on Monday.
