Today – The low-pressure system is passing to the north today producing strong gusty winds of 25 gusting to 35-40 mph early this morning. These winds will gradually decrease down to 15-20 gusting to 25 mph by late afternoon. Otherwise, a mix of sun and clouds can be expected with the chance for a few showers passing between late morning to early afternoon.

Extended forecast – The low-pressure system finally moves far enough away to allow high pressure to build over the region briefly Friday providing more tranquil conditions. A strong low-pressure system will develop over the northeastern U.S. and slowly move a cold front across Bermuda this weekend. Showers will become likely on Saturday and continue through the day Sunday. Finally, this system will move east of Bermuda Monday allowing drier conditions to return.
