Today – Areas of fog that roll in and off the course are forecast to lift between 8-9am. Mostly cloudy skies are forecast throughout the day, with isolated pop-up showers or thunderstorms becoming possible in the early afternoon. A few additional showers and storms will flare up during the late afternoon and evening hours, but the more widespread chances for rain/storms should hold off until the overnight hours/early Monday. Muggy conditions are forecast with temperatures climbing into the mid-80s. An inconsistent southeasterly breeze in the afternoon may produce a few gusts in the 15-17 mph range after 2-3pm.

Tomorrow – Unsettled conditions on Monday as rounds of showers and thunderstorms are anticipated as a storm system moves out of the Ohio Valley and into the Mid-Atlantic. A potential lull could occur in the late morning to early afternoon hours before atmospheric instability recovers, and widespread activity redevelops. Southerly winds are forecast with temperatures climbing into the low 80s.
