**Today** – Partly cloudy skies can be expected throughout the day, however a pocket of deeper moisture should will spread over the area late this morning into the afternoon. This likely leads to an uptick in shower activity, with greatest coverage between 2-8pm. Easterly winds will remain brisk this morning with gusts over 20 mph possible. Winds likely weaken a bit for the afternoon hours. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.25". **Sunrise: 6:34am / Sunset: 6:45pm**

**Extended forecast** – The easterly Trade winds will begin to diminish Friday and especially this weekend as a cold front approaches from the Northwest. Moisture levels likely remain below normal Friday/Saturday so the threat for showers will be low. Moisture should begin increase Sunday into Monday with a higher threat for showers developing as the front moves overhead. Winds should turn more southeasterly by the weekend with speeds falling below 15 mph, especially Saturday afternoon through Sunday.
