**Things to Know**

- **Will Zalatoris** seeks first PGA TOUR title in his 40<sup>th</sup> start at the site of his first professional start on TOUR
- Australia's **Jason Day** looks for his 13<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR title and third at Farmers Insurance Open
- England's **Aaron Rai** sits T3, his best position after any of his 55 rounds on TOUR
- **Jon Rahm** trying to become first World No. 1 to win on TOUR since Dustin Johnson (2020 Masters Tournament)
- Each of the last three Farmers Insurance Open champions opened on the North Course; Rai and **Sungjae Im** (T5) began the tournament on the North Course
- **Cameron Young** fires 8-under 64 for low score of the week on South Course

- 7 Third-round leaders/co-leaders since 2000 to win the Farmers Insurance Open: Patrick Reed (2021), Justin Rose (2019), Tiger Woods (2003, 2008, 2013), John Daly (2004), Phil Mickelson (2000)
- 4 Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win in 2021-22 (most recent: Cameron Smith/Sentry Tournament of Champions)

**Will Zalatoris (T1/-14)**

- After a 339-yard tee shot at the par-4 second hole, holed a 40-yard pitch for eagle; added birdies at Nos. 4, 8, 9, 10 and 14 for a bogey-free 65 (-7)
- Eagle at No. 2 marked his third in in a 20-hole stretch (carded eagles on his opening and closing holes on the North Course in round two)
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for first time in TOUR career; only other lead after any round was R2/2021 Sanderson Farms Championship/T14
- Posts his third lowest score in 23 rounds this season (61/R2/Sanderson Farms Championship, 61/R2/The American Express)

- Making third appearance at Farmers Insurance Open (MC/2018, T7/2021); his first professional start on TOUR came at this event in 2018
- Seeks first PGA TOUR title in 40<sup>th</sup> start; last first-time winner at Farmers Insurance Open was John Rahm (2017)
- Runner-up at 2021 Masters Tournament is best of nine top-10s on TOUR

#### Jason Day (T1/-14)

- Birdies last three holes en route to 5-under 67
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for 15<sup>th</sup> time on TOUR, going on to win seven of previous 14, most recently 2018 Wells Fargo Championship
- Seeks third Farmers Insurance Open title in his 13<sup>th</sup> appearance (2015, 2018); two victories are among five top-10s at this event (T9/2013, T2/2014, T5/2019)
- Looks to join Tiger Woods (7) and Phil Mickelson (3) as players with three or more titles at this event
- Last of 12 wins on TOUR was 2018 Wells Fargo Championship; most recent top-10 on TOUR was T10/2021 Travelers Championship
- Entered this week No. 197 in FedExCup standings; No. 114 in the FedExCup last season marked the first time ending a season outside the top 90 in the FedExCup since becoming a TOUR member in 2008

#### Additional Player Notes

- Two-time DP World Tour winner and PGA TOUR rookie **Aaron Rai** (T3/-13) birdies final two holes for 4-under 68; sat T6 after round two and sits T3 after round three, his two best positions after any rounds on TOUR (55 rounds); previous best position after any round prior to this week was T12
- **Jon Rahm** (T3/-13) made his first career birdie at No. 15 in 21 rounds at the South Course (includes 2021 U.S. Open rounds); his double bogey at No. 10 marked his first double bogey in his previous 393 holes played on TOUR; his last double bogey prior was at the 2021 FedEx St. Jude Championship (No. 13/R3)
- **Sungjae Im** (T5/-12) looks to continue his streak of improving his result in each appearance at Farmers Insurance Open (T52/2019, T36/2020, T32/2021)
- **Cameron Tringale** (T5/-12) has the most starts without a win since 2009 of players seeking their first career TOUR title (317 starts); with four runner-up results, most recently at the 2021 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, he is currently the player with the most prize money without a victory (\$15,625,813)
- 2017 FedExCup Champion **Justin Thomas** (T5/-12) bids for a third consecutive top-5 finish this season
- **Maverick McNealy** (T8/-11) makes his second hole-in-one on TOUR, holing an 8-iron from 165 yards at No. 8 en route to his lowest score in this event (13 rounds); first ace came at 2021 John Deere Classic
- **Cameron Young** (T8/-11), reached 9-under on his round through 16 holes before closing bogey-par for 8-under 64; former teammate with Will Zalatoris at Wake Forest, missed the cut in his first PGA TOUR event as a professional at the 2021 Farmers Insurance Open after advancing out of Monday qualifying in a 5-for-2 playoff
- **Sahith Theegala** (T27/-8) three-putted the 12<sup>th</sup> hole to end his TOUR-leading streak of 314 consecutive holes without a three-putt
- After making the 36-hole cut by one stroke, La Jolla, California native **Xander Schauffele** (T33/-7) posted a bogey-free inward nine of 31 (5-under), which included five birdies in a six-hole stretch (Nos.1-6)
