In Focus: Season Highlights



Congratulations to Scottie Scheffler, this season's winner of the Aon Risk Reward Challenge on the PGA TOUR. Throughout the season, Scottie's ability to navigate the most strategically challenging holes on the PGA TOUR separated him from the rest of the contenders, making it difficult to catch up after making birdie on the 16th hole at the Genesis Scottish Open.

Scheffler's rise to the number one player in the world and four wins on the TOUR has showcased his all-around game. This world-class ability translated to his success on the Aon Risk Reward Challenge. Across the Aon Risk Reward Challenge holes, Scheffler had a go-for-green rate of 74 percent with a strong 20 percent success rate across the drivable par-4's and reachable par-5's on the schedule. Scheffler's confidence in his short game was crucial. Although his average proximity to the hole was below field average when going for it, his skilled wedge play and putting still allowed him to gain strokes on the field. In all, Scheffler led in both birdies (29) and eagles (3) on the Aon Risk Reward Challenge holes.

As part of the PGA TOUR winning moment activation, a press release will be shared Tuesday, August 9th, announcing Scottie as the 2021-2022 winner. Aon and supporting media partners will continue the cadence of celebration throughout the week, with social, digital, and linear announcements to come in the following days. At the end of the regular season, the most consistent player across each tour, wins the Aon Trophy and a \$1 million prize.

Aon Risk Reward Challenge Scoring

- One hole is selected at each tournament as the designated Aon Risk Reward Challenge hole for the week (hole is strategically challenge in nature)
- For each participating event, a player's best two scores on the designated hole counts towards the season-long leaderboard
- The player with the lowest average score to par across the regular season wins the Aon Risk Reward Challenge
