Today – Patchy fog may yet roll into the area this morning but would likely lift by 8am should it develop over TPC Southwind. There is a slow-moving frontal boundary over the area that will gradually drift southward through the day. Although the day will feature more dry time than not, chances for slow-moving pop-up showers or thunderstorms will be a possibility throughout the day due to the frontal boundary and high moisture values in place. Temperatures will top out in the upper 80s, with a heat index approaching 100°F. **Forecast rainfall through 7pm: 0.10" – 0.25"; locally higher amounts to 1" possible in heavy T-storms. Observed rainfall yesterday afternoon/overnight: 0.10" Sunrise: 6:16am / Sunset: 7:52pm**
