STORYLINES

Co-sanctioned for the first time: As part of the Strategic Alliance between the PGA TOUR and DP World Tour, the Genesis Scottish Open is co-sanctioned by the two tours for the first time. The winner will receive benefits from both tours, including 500 FedExCup points, 1,335 DP World Tour Ranking points, an exemption on the PGA TOUR through 2024 and on the DP World Tour through 2025.

In addition, there are 50 places available for DP World Tour players in this week's Barbasol Championship and next week's Barracuda Championship on the PGA TOUR, where the winner will also receive points and exemptions from both tours.

Open Qualifying Series: Both the Genesis Scottish Open and Barbasol Championship are part of the Open Qualifying Series with spots available at the Genesis Scottish Open to the top three players in the top 10 not otherwise exempt and one available at the Barbasol Championship (top five). The qualifying place available at the Barbasol Championship is the last chance to qualify for The Open Championship. Seven players have qualified for The Open Championship via QQS at PGA TOUR events this season: Chris Kirk and Talor Gooch at the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard; Wyndham Clark and Keith Mitchell at the RBC Canadian Open; J.T. Poston, Christiaan Bezuidenhout and Emiliano Grillo at the John Deere Classic.

Fitzpatrick is back: World No. 10 Matt Fitzpatrick is making his first start since winning the U.S. Open in June. Fitzpatrick, who lost to Min Woo Lee in a playoff at the 2021 Genesis Scottish Open, has four top-10s in his last five starts, including the win at the U.S. Open and a T5 at the PGA Championship. Fitzpatrick has been No. 10 in the Official World Golf Ranking since winning the U.S. Open, the highest position of his career.

PLAYER STORYLINES

Xander Schauffele is making his first start since winning the Travelers Championship. Schauffele, who has six career wins on TOUR and two this season, won in back-to-back starts during the 2018-19 season (WGC-HSBC Champions, Sentry Tournament of Champions). With a win, Schauffele would become the third player with three or more wins this season, joining Scottie Scheffler (4) and Sam Burns (3).

Two players in the top 20 in the FedExCup standings have not won a tournament this season: reigning PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year **Will Zalatoris** (No. 9) and rookie **Cameron Young** (No. 18), who played college golf together at Wake Forest. They are also the two highest-ranked players in the Official World Golf Ranking that have not won on the PGA TOUR in their careers (Zalatoris/No. 13, Young/No. 31).

PGA TOUR rookie **Aaron Rai** won the Genesis Scottish Open in 2020 in a playoff over Tommy Fleetwood, his second career title on the DP World Tour. Rai earned his PGA TOUR card for this season via the 2021 Korn Ferry Tour Finals and is currently No. 77 in the FedExCup standings in his first season on TOUR (best result: T4, Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner David Lipsky).

Rickie Fowler, who was originally in the field as a sponsor exemption but gone in on his own number, enters the week No. 123 in the FedExCup standings. Fowler missed the FedExCup Playoffs for the first time in his career last season and needs to remain in the top 125 over the final five weeks to qualify in 2022.

Three players that finished in the top 10 at last week's John Deere Classic are in the field: **Christiaan Bezuidenhout** (T2), **Callum Tarren** (T6) and **Maverick McNealy** (T8). Bezuidenhout's runner-up result was the best to date of his PGA TOUR career and second career top-10. He qualified for The Open Championship via the Open Qualifying Series and will make his third career start in the event next week (MC/2019, T53/2021).

Four-time PGA TOUR winner **Harris English** is making his ninth start of the season and fourth since returning from injury at the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday. English finished T19 at the Travelers Championship in his most recent start, his first top-25 of the season, and enters the week No. 198 in the FedExCup standings. He has missed the FedExCup Playoffs once since joining the PGA TOUR in 2012 (2018-19 season).

Six players have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in each season since the inception in 2007, and two of the six are in the field this week: **Matt Kuchar** and **Charley Hoffman**. Hoffman enters the week No. 179 in the FedExCup standings and has five weeks remaining to move up and keep the streak alive, while Kuchar is No. 48.

Strategic Alliance: The Keene Trace Golf Club (Champions) will host the Barbasol Championship for the fourth time with a field comprised of players from both the PGA TOUR and DP World Tour. There are 50 places available for the top players from the DP World Tour priority ranking. The Barbasol Championship winner will receive benefits on each Tour:

FedExCup points: 300
 DP World Tour Rankings points: 710
 PGA TOUR exemption (for current PGA TOUR members): thru 2024
 PGA TOUR exemption (for non-members): thru 2022-23
 DP World Tour exemption: thru 2024

Final five: Five weeks remain in the FedExCup Regular Season, with the Barbasol Championship providing an opportunity for players to make a run towards one of the 125 spots in the FedExCup Playoffs. Six players have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in each season since the inception in 2007, including Brandt Snedeker who is currently outside the top 125 at No. 173 in the FedExCup standings.

Sponsor exemption spotlight: Danville, Kentucky native and Morehead State University graduate Josh Teater will be making his fifth start at the Barbasol Championship and second of the season (T22/Puerto Rico Open). Teater seeks his third consecutive top 25 finish at Keene Trace Golf Club (T6/2019, T15/2021).

FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

Last time out: J.T. Poston won the John Deere Classic in wire-to-wire fashion, earning his second PGA TOUR title and first since the 2019 Wyndham Championship. Poston became the second player this season to win wire-to-wire, joining Joaquin Niemann, and qualified for The Open Championship via the Open Qualifying Series.

No. 1: World No. 1 and FedExCup leader Scottie Scheffler finished T2 at the U.S. Open to set the PGA TOUR record for most official money earned in a season at \$12,896,849 (previous: \$12,030,465/Jordan Spieth/2014-15). With his third runner-up finish of the season, the four-time TOUR winner became the fourth player (eighth instance) since the start of the 2000 season to record four or more wins and three or more runner-up finishes in a season, joining Tiger Woods (4), Phil Mickelson (2) and Jordan Spieth.
