- 22** Jordan Spieth won the FedExCup in 2015 at the age of 22, the youngest FedExCup champion in 15 FedExCup seasons
- 1** Rory McIlroy is the only player to win the FedExCup title multiple times and the DPWT multiple times since 2007
- 2** Rory McIlroy (FEC/5 & DPWT/8) and Justin Rose (FEC/6 & DPWT/7) are the only players finishing inside the Top-10 five or more times on both season-long races since 2007
- 3** Three players (McIlroy, Stenson & Rose) have won both the FedExCup and DP World Tour (since 2007)
- 4** Matt Fitzpatrick is one of six players with at least three seasons finishing in the top 10 on the DPWT and not qualifying for the PGA TOUR's season-ending TOUR Championship.
