Things to Know

- Cameron Tringale opens with a 9-under 61, the lowest score of his PGA TOUR career (1,058th round on TOUR)
- Tringale holds his fourth first-round lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR (0-for-3 to date)
- World No. 1 and FedExCup leader Scottie Scheffler opens with a 3-over 73
- 2021 Genesis Scottish Open champion Min Woo Lee posts a 7-over 77
- The top three players not otherwise exempt who finish in the top 10 this week gain entry into The Open Championship
- As part of the Strategic Alliance between the PGA TOUR and DP World Tour, the Genesis Scottish Open is co-sanctioned by the two tours for the first time

Cameron Tringale (1st/-9)

- Opens with a bogey-free 9-under 61, the lowest score of his PGA TOUR career (1,058th round on TOUR)
- Round includes a career-best six consecutive birdies (Nos. 10-15); previous-best was five in a row (four times)
- Ties personal-best mark with nine birdies in a round (2022 The American Express/R2)
- Holds a three-stroke lead over Gary Woodland; marks his fourth first-round lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR (0-for-3 to date; most recently finishing T6 at the 2017 Barbasol Championship)
- Marks the eighth opening-round score of 61 or better on TOUR this season, led by Sebastian Munoz with 60s to open the AT&T Byron Nelson and The RSM Classic
- Ranks No. 109 on the career money list on the PGA TOUR, the highest position by a player without a victory
- Has the most starts (332) without a win of any player on TOUR since 2009 (Ricky Barnes is second on the list with 306)
- Finished T53 in his only other start at the Genesis Scottish Open (2015)

Miscellaneous notes

With a 64, 2019 U.S. Open champion **Gary Woodland** equals his best opening-round score on TOUR (fifth instance in 313 starts)

- Jordan Spieth cards an opening-round 68 with five consecutive birdies on Nos. 13-17, one shy of a career-best six birdies in a row in round one of the 2020 RBC Heritage
- World No. 1 and FedExCup leader Scottie Scheffler posts a 3-over 73, his highest opening-round score since beginning his season with a 74 at the Shriners Children's Open
- Defending champion **Min Woo Lee** records a 7-over 77
- One week prior to his title defense at The Open Championship, **Collin Morikawa** posts a 1-over 71
- Richie Ramsay (illness) withdrew prior to the first round and was replaced by Callum Shinkwin (4-over 74)
