Things to Know

- One day following a career-best 61, Cameron Tringale maintains three-shot lead following a 2-over 72
- Tringale holds his third second-round lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR (0-for-2 to date)
- Two of the last three winners on TOUR turn in the rounds of the day: Travelers Championship winner Xander Schauffele (65) and U.S. Open champion Matt Fitzpatrick (66)
- With his ace on the par-3 17th hole, Jordan Smith won a Genesis GV70; his caddie, Sam Matton, receives a GV60
- World No. 1 and FedExCup leader Scottie Scheffler misses the cut with rounds of 73-72
- One week prior to defending his title at The Open Championship, Collin Morikawa misses the cut with rounds of 71-74
- Additional notables to miss the cut: defending champion Min Woo Lee, Justin Thomas, Will Zalatoris, Hideki Matsuyama, Viktor Hovland
- The top three players not otherwise exempt who finish in the top 10 this week gain entry into The Open Championship

- 2 Second-round leaders/co-leaders to win the Genesis Scottish Open since 2010 (most recent: Bernd Wiesberger, 2019)
- Second-round leaders/co-leaders to win individual stroke-play events on TOUR in 2021-22 (most recent: J.T. Poston, John Deere Classic)

- Followed the lowest score of his PGA TOUR career (61) with a 2-over 72, maintaining a three-stroke lead
- Third second-round lead/co-lead on TOUR (0-for-2 to date; most recently finishing T9 at the 2021 Valero Texas Open)
- Ranks No. 109 on the career money list on the PGA TOUR, the highest position by a player without a victory
- Has the most starts (332) without a win of any player on TOUR since 2009 (Ricky Barnes is second on the list with 306)
- Owns four runner-up finishes on TOUR, most recently at the 2021 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP
- Finished T53 in his only other start at the Genesis Scottish Open (2015)

- Gary Woodland (T2) is making his 68th start since the last of his four PGA TOUR victories (2019 U.S. Open)
- **Doug Ghim** (T2) owns two top-10 finishes in 79 prior TOUR starts, including a T6 at this season's PLAYERS Championship (T5/2021 American Express)
- 2022 Travelers Championship winner Xander Schauffele (T4) posts the round of the day with a 5-under 65
- Despite bogeys on his final two holes, reigning U.S. Open champion **Matt Fitzpatrick** (T4) posts 4-under 66; has been inside the top 10 on the leaderboard in 15 of his last 19 rounds on TOUR
- With his ace on the par-3 17th hole, **Jordan Smith** (T4) won a Genesis GV70; his caddie, **Sam Matton**, receives a GV60
- One week prior to his title defense at The Open Championship, Collin Morikawa misses the cut with rounds of 71-74
- World No. 1 and FedExCup leader Scottie Scheffler (73-72) misses the cut for just the third time in 21 starts this season
- Defending champion Min Woo Lee misses the cut with rounds of 77-74
- Thomas Bjorn was disqualified for signing an incorrect scorecard
- David Horsey (injury) withdrew prior to the second round
