TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

Back to Memorial Park: The Hewlett Packard Enterprise Open returned to Memorial Park Golf Course in 2020, debuting a renovation from Tom Doak (on which Brooks Koepka served as player consultant). Prior to 2020, Memorial Park last hosted the event in 1963, and has produced notable winners such as Arnold Palmer, Cary Middlecoff and Jack Burke, Jr. Memorial Park is one of just two municipal golf courses on the PGA TOUR schedule (other: Torrey Pines, Farmers Insurance Open).

Tough test: Memorial Park was the fourth-hardest course on the PGA TOUR during the 2020-21 season among non-majors, while No. 16 was the most difficult par 5 on such courses.

21 of the top 50: 21 of the top 50 players in the Official World Golf Ranking are set to compete, which represents seven more than in 2020 and 19 more than 2019, when the tournament moved to the fall portion of the schedule.

FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

Last time out: Viktor Hovland successfully defended his title at the World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba, becoming the first player to win a PGA TOUR event back-to-back since Brooks Koepka won the PGA Championship in 2018 and 2019.

Five consecutive international winners: Players from outside the United States have won on the PGA TOUR five weeks in a row, one week shy of the longest such streak on record (1960-present). There have been two streaks of six weeks in that span. International players have won this event 17 times since 1970, tied for the most on TOUR in that span.

SPONSOR EXEMPTION SPOTLIGHT

Houston resident Chris Stroud is making his 14th start in the Hewlett Packard Enterprise Open since joining the PGA TOUR at the beginning of the 2007 season, tying Hunter Mahan for the most appearances in that stretch. Stroud has recorded two top-25s at the event, highlighted by a T12 in 2014.

Stroud was given a sponsor exemption (one of two for members not otherwise exempt) and is competing on TOUR this season on a medical extension. He has 17 starts remaining and needs 440.355 FedExCup points to earn top 125 points and play the remainder of the season out of the Major Medical Extension category. If he earns at least 287.137 points in those starts, he will be eligible for the 126-150 category for the remainder of the season.
