Things to Know

- A day after setting the course record, Scottie Scheffler holds his second 54-hole lead on TOUR
- Scheffler, a Dallas, Texas native, seeks first career TOUR victory in his 67th start
- Martin Trainer, who held at least a share of the first and second round lead, plays the third round 4-over 74; seeks second TOUR title and first since 2019 Puerto Rico Open
- Matthew Wolff seeks third top-10 finish of the season
- Houston resident Jhonattan Vegas, Kramer Hickok and Kevin Tway also sit one back heading into Sunday

- Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win the Hewlett Packard Enterprise Houston Open since 2000 (includes each of the two of the last three: Ian Poulter/2018, Lanto Griffin/2019)
- Third-round leaders/co-leaders to win in 2021-22 (Hideki Matsuyama/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, Viktor Hovland/ World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba)

- After setting the course record of 8-under 62 during round two, followed with 1-under 69 and enters the final round with a one-stroke lead
- Holds second 54-hole lead/co-lead on PGA TOUR (3rd/2020 The American Express)
- Comes off a solo-fourth at last week's World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba

- Seeks his first career PGA TOUR title in his 67th start this week; best finish is solo-second at the 2021 World Golf Championships-Dell Technologies Match Play
- Making third start at the Hewlett Packard Enterprise Houston Open (T28/2019, T32/2020)
- Seeks to become the third consecutive player to make the Hewlett Packard Enterprise Houston Open his first career TOUR title (Lanto Griffin/2019, Carlos Ortiz/2020) and eighth to achieve the feat since 2000
- Looks to become second first-time PGA TOUR winner this season (Lucas Herbert/Butterfield Bermuda Championship)
- Finished last season No. 22 in the FedExCup standings with eight top-10s

- Houston resident Jhonattan Vegas (T2/-6) seeks fourth TOUR title in his 259th start and first victory since 2017
 RBC Canadian Open; making his 11th start at Hewlett Packard Enterprise Houston Open (best: T15/2017), leads the
 field in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee through three rounds (3.387)
- Making his first start in the event and fourth of the season, Matthew Wolff (T2/-6) enters the week with back-to-back top-five finishes (2nd/Shriners Children's Open, T5/World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba);
 seeks second career PGA TOUR title in his 53rd TOUR start (2019 3M Open)
- Kramer Hickok (T2/-6) seeks first career TOUR victory in his 78th start; with a win, would join Mackenzie Hughes (2016), Adam Hadwin (2017) and Aaron Wise (2018) as players to win on Mackenzie Tour-PGA TOUR Canada, Korn Ferry Tour and PGA TOUR
- Following Martin Trainer's (T2/-6) first 18-hole lead/co-lead and 36-hole outright lead on TOUR, plays the third round 4-over 74; plays on the weekend for just the 10th time in 71 starts since his maiden victory at the 2019 Puerto Rico Open; best showing in that time frame in a full-field TOUR event was T41/2019 THE PLAYERS Championship
- Making his third start at the Hewlett Packard Enterprise Houston Open (T32/2018, MC/2021), **Kevin Tway** (T2/-6) seeks second career TOUR title and first since the 2018 Fortinet Championship; leads the field with eagles (2)
- **Vincent Whaley** (T10/-4) fires off 5-under 65, the low round of the day; seeks second top-10 of the season (T7/Butterfield Bermuda Championship)
