Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 & FedExCup Storylines

9 Nine of 13 John Deere Classic champions qualified for the TOUR Championship in the FEC era

Only one John Deere Classic champion has won the FedExCup title in the same season (Spieth/2015)

Over 1K Four players have earned over 1,000 FedExCup points at the John Deere Classic in the last 12 years (Steve Stricker, Zach Johnson, Jordan Spieth & Ryan Moore)

+12 Xander Schauffele moved from 20th to Eighth in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 with his victory at the Travelers Championship, his first week inside the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 this season and third time in the last four seasons ranked in the TOUR TOP 10 with six weeks remaining in the FedExCup regular season.

1,256 Lead in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 held by Scottie Scheffler, the second-largest lead with six weeks left of a FedExCup regular season since 2009 (2015 Jordan Spieth, 1,713)

76% Since 2009, 76% of the players in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 with six weeks remaining have finished in the final Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 (99 of 130)

In 2013-14, Rory McIlroy was 40th in the FedExCup with six weeks left in the FedExCup regular season and finished No. 1 in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10, marking the lowest FedExCup rank with six weeks left of any player finishing No. 1 in the TOUR TOP 10 (since 2009)

In each of the last two seasons, the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 with six weeks left in the FedExCup regular season notched a combined 67 top-10s, tied for the second-most combined top-10s of the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 with six weeks to go (since 2009).
