

### Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Lucas Glover earned his fourth career PGA TOUR victory in his 454<sup>th</sup> TOUR start at the 2021 John Deere Classic. Glover recorded his first win in 10 years, 2 months, and 3 days.
