Today – A cold front will pass through the Quad Cities this morning with little, to no, precipitation development expected. A weak upper-level disturbance will pass to the south early this afternoon and could squeeze out a few light rain showers between 11am-3pm. Otherwise, dry conditions are favored during the day. Winds will be out of the north at 12 mph, or less, with temperatures reaching the middle 80s. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.05” **Sunrise: 5:31am / Sunset: 8:39pm**
