Extended forecast – A weak cold front will push through the Quad Cities Friday morning with showers and embedded T-storms possible. The threat for precipitation likely diminishes by the early afternoon. This front will settle south of the area on Saturday then lift back northward as a warm front Sunday. While precipitation can't be ruled out either day, the forecast will keep rain chances at 10-15%, and dry conditions favored.
