TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

Game-time decision: 82-time PGA TOUR winner and five-time Masters Tournament champion Tiger Woods announced that he will make a "game-time decision" on whether he can return to competition this week. Woods suffered significant injuries to his right leg and ankle in a February 2021 car accident and has not competed on the PGA TOUR since the 2020 Masters. The 508 days between the final round of the 2020 Masters and first round of the 2022 Masters would be the second-longest span between competitive rounds of Woods' PGA TOUR career.

On top of the world: Scottie Scheffler enters the Masters Tournament holding the top spot in both the FedExCup standings and Official World Golf Ranking. Scheffler has wins in three of his last five starts and is the first player to win three times in a PGA TOUR season prior to the Masters since Dustin Johnson and Justin Thomas in the 2016-17 season.

Elite company: Two-time FedExCup Champion Rory McIlroy can become the sixth player to complete the career Grand Slam with a win this week, joining Tiger Woods, Jack Nicklaus, Gary Player, Ben Hogan and Gene Sarazen.

Two in a row: Hideki Matsuyama can become the first player to win the Masters back-to-back since Tiger Woods in 2001 and 2002. Matsuyama is one of four players with multiple titles on TOUR this season (ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, Sony Open in Hawaii).

FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

No. 1: Scottie Scheffler won his third TOUR title at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play, his third victory in his last five starts, to take over the No. 1 position in the Official World Golf Ranking on March 27 for the first time in his career. Scheffler is the 25th player to hold the World No. 1 title (est. 1986) and sixth-youngest. Jon Rahm had held the top spot for 36 consecutive weeks before Scheffler's victory. Scheffler also holds the lead in the FedExCup standings, becoming the first FedExCup leader to win on TOUR (outside of the TOUR Championship) since Justin Thomas at the 2020 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational. The player that entered the Masters as World No. 1 has won five times (Ian Woosnam/1991, Fred Couples/1992, Tiger Woods/2001, Woods/2002, Dustin Johnson/2020), while the FedExCup leader has never won the Masters.

Youth movement: On March 6 (and March 13), all of the top five in the Official World Golf Ranking were younger than 30 for the first time (est. 1986). All five players remain in the top five but Patrick Cantlay turned 30* on Thursday, March 17.

Top players taking the title: 11 of the 24 PGA TOUR events this season have been won by players who began the tournament in the top 25 of the Official World Golf Ranking, with the highest ranking by a winner this season coming with Scottie Scheffler's third victory (No. 5 entering the week). 24 of the top 25 players in the OWGR are competing this week at the Masters Tournament (all but No. 23 Harris English).

First-time winners: Nine players have earned their first PGA TOUR victory this season, including seven in the last 10 weeks. Most recently, J.J. Spaun won the Valero Texas Open, winning on TOUR for the first time in his 147th career start. There are 18 players in the field at the Masters Tournament that have not won on the PGA TOUR (19.8%). The last player to earn his first PGA TOUR victory in a major championship was Danny Willett at the 2016 Masters.

Season of championships: The Masters Tournament is the first major championship of the season and second of five events offering 600 FedExCup points to the winner. Cameron Smith won THE PLAYERS Championship in March, earning his fifth PGA TOUR title and second of the season. At No. 10, Smith became the third consecutive winner of THE PLAYERS Championship to enter the week in the top 10 of the Official World Golf Ranking.
