7 AM Weather Forecast

Thursday, April 7, 2022



Synopsis: The rain and thunderstorms have finally moved off to the east early this morning leaving cloudy skies. Some mist or drizzle may be possible through 9 AM with an isolated shower chance through 11 AM before the drier air over spreads the area from the west. Otherwise, clearing skies can be expected this afternoon with mild and breezy conditions with highs in the low to mid 70s. Friday and Saturday will feature cooler and blustery weather with lows in the 40s and afternoon highs in the upper 60s Friday, while struggling to reach 60 degrees on Saturday. Sunny skies each morning will give way to mostly cloudy skies during the afternoon. Cannot rule out isolated afternoon light showers, but the better chances for seeing these showers will be across Northern Georgia at this time. After a cold start Sunday morning with lows in the 30s, temperatures rebound into the lower 70s for the afternoon under sunny skies and lighter winds.

Partly cloudy becoming mostly cloudy, breezy and chilly in the afternoon.

20% chance for isolated light showers during the afternoon.

Low: 40F High: 59F Winds: W-NW 12-18, G 25-28 mph

Mostly sunny and warmer after a cold start.

Low: 37F High: 72F Winds: NW 7-14 mph
