Today – Strong, gusty winds of 20-25 gusting to 35-40 mph can be expected through late morning before decreasing mid-day into the afternoon as a cold front slowly approaches from the northwest. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop late afternoon into the evening and become more numerous later tonight as the front slowly moves through the area. Storms could be severe during the evening with strong winds, hail and heavy rainfall.

Extended forecast – Showers and isolated thunderstorms will be likely on Saturday as the front slowly works southward. Showers should taper off by mid to late afternoon with northerly winds increasing to 15-20 gusting to 30 mph. Temperatures will be much cooler with highs in the mid 60s tomorrow morning and dropping into the 50s for the afternoon. Drier conditions and cool temperatures can be expected Sunday before showers and thunderstorms return Monday.
