Today – Early morning thunderstorms are moving to the east with lingering showers remaining possible for the next couple of hours. Otherwise, mostly cloudy skies will give way to mostly sunny skies for the afternoon. It will be another hot day with highs in the low 90s. Southerly winds of 5-10 mph will increase to 15-20 gusting to 30 mph late afternoon into the evening.

Extended forecast – Strong winds are likely Friday morning 15-25 G 45 mph before gradually decreasing to 15-20 G 25-30 mph for the afternoon. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop towards evening as a cold front approaches from the north. Storms could be severe Friday night with large hail, strong winds and heavy rainfall. Showers and isolated t-storms will linger through the day Saturday as the front slowly moves to the south. Temperatures will be cooling into the 60s through the day as well. After a chilly start Sunday morning, temperatures should warm to around 70 degrees under partly cloudy skies.
