### TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

**Elevated event No. 2:** The Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard is one of three PGA TOUR events with elevated status, along with The Genesis Invitational and the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday. Those three events offer a larger purse (\$12 million; up from \$9.3 million in 2021), an increased allotment of FedExCup points (550 to the winner) and a three-year PGA TOUR exemption for the winner.

**Field force:** The 2022 field features 10 of the top 25 in the Official World Golf Ranking, led by World No. 1 Jon Rahm who will make his Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard debut. Defending champion Bryson DeChambeau withdrew Monday from the tournament due to injury.

**Rookie recognition:** The Arnold Palmer Award is given annually to the PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year and in 2021, the honor went to Will Zalatoris, who will make his second start in the event (T10/2021). Zalatoris is one of 11 players to be named Rookie of the Year in this week's field.

**Green machine:** In 2021 the field hit 56.84% of greens in regulation at Bay Hill Club & Lodge, marking the fifth-toughest Green in Regulation percentage overall on TOUR last season and second among non-majors.

### TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

**Springboard to Stardom:** Since the tournament's 2008 inception, the Puerto Rico Open has helped elevate the careers of future PGA TOUR stars, including Daniel Berger (T2/2019) and past sponsor exemptions Jordan Spieth (T2/2013) and Brooks Koepka (T19/2014). Bryson DeChambeau lost in a playoff at the 2017 Puerto Rico Open and went on to win his first PGA TOUR title later that season, while Tony Finau (2016) and Viktor Hovland (2020) won their first TOUR titles at the Puerto Rico Open. Branden Grace, who won the 2021 Puerto Rico Open, is in the field at Bay Hill Club & Lodge.

**Win this week and play next week:** The Puerto Rico Open winner receives 300 FedExCup points, a two-year exemption on the PGA TOUR and an invitation to THE PLAYERS Championship (if not previously eligible) and other select events. Joseph Bramlett, Brice Garnett, Kyle Stanley, Brian Stuard and Richy Werenski mark the only commits at the Grand Reserve Golf Club who are already eligible for THE PLAYERS Championship next week.

### FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

**Last week on TOUR:** Sepp Straka earned his first PGA TOUR title in his 95th career start at the age of 28 years, 9 months, 26 days at The Honda Classic. Entering the final round five strokes back, Straka carded a 66 to mark largest final-round comeback at the tournament since it moved to PGA National in 2007. The Vienna, Austria native became the first player from Austria to win on TOUR.

## EXEMPTION SPOTLIGHT

**Open Qualifying Series:** The Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard is the first of five PGA TOUR events that is part of the Open Qualifying Series where 12 spots will be available into The 150th Open at St. Andrews.

The top three players, not otherwise exempt, in the top 10 and ties at the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard will earn an exemption. In the event of a tie for a qualifying place, the player with the higher OWGR at the beginning of the respective week, will earn the spot. Other events on the PGA TOUR schedule include RBC Canadian Open (two spots), John Deere Classic (three spots), Genesis Scottish Open (three spots) and Barbasol Championship (one spot).

Keith Mitchell earned the Open Qualifying spot at the Arnold Palmer Invitational in the last two opportunities (2019, 2020).

### SPONSOR EXEMPTION SPOTLIGHT

Puerto Rico native Rafael Campos will make his 13th appearance at the Puerto Rico Open. Last season, Campos posted two top-three results on TOUR in a 29-day span with T3 at 2021 Puerto Rico Open and T2 at 2021 Corales Puntacana Championship; was 54-hole leader/co-leader at both events.

In 51 TOUR starts, Campos owns five career top-10s, with three at the Puerto Rico Open (T8/2016, T10/2017, T3/2021). The other pair of top-10s came at the 2017 Hewlett Packard Enterprise Houston Open (7th) and 2021 Corales Puntacana Championship (T2). This past summer Campos represented his home country at the 2020 Olympic Games and finished T57.
