Things to Know

- Making his final start on a Minor Medical Extension needing a win or solo-second to retain status, Ryan Brehm leads/co-leads for the first time in his career after any round on the PGA TOUR
- Brehm is the only player in the field bogey-free through 36 holes
- Michael Kim and Satoshi Kodaira, both PGA TOUR winners in 2018, sit T2 at 10-under, each seeking a second title
- PGA TOUR rookie Max McGreevy fires career-low round (64) and low round of the day in his 11th TOUR start
- Satoshi Kodaira (279) is the only player at 9-under or better inside No. 300 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- Amateur Chris Gotterup sits T6 after a pair of 68s; last amateur to win on TOUR was Phil Mickelson in 1991
- Puerto Rico native Rafa Campos advances to the weekend for the eighth time in 13 appearances at the Puerto Rico Open

Ryan Brehm (1st/-11)

- Michigander finishes birdie-eagle for a 5-under 67 to sit 11-under with a one-stroke lead; only player in the field bogey-free through 36 holes
- Holds lead/co-lead for the first time after any round on the PGA TOUR; previous-best position after any round was T4/R1/2020 Wyndham Championship (finished T31)
- Seeks first PGA TOUR title in 68th start while playing his final event on a Minor Medical Extension
- Victory this week would satisfy Minor Medical Extension and earn full exempt status for the remainder of this season, plus the next two seasons; solo-second would allow him to play out of the 126-150 category the remainder of this season
- Best result of three top-25s on TOUR: T11 at 2021 Puerto Rico Open where he posted 68-71-69-67—275 (-13)

- Owns two Korn Ferry Tour titles: 2016 WinCo Foods Portland Open, 2019 LECOM Health Challenge
- Finished T9 at Astara Golf Championship in Colombia last month, his first top-10 on the Korn Ferry Tour since August 2019

Miscellaneous Notes

- Playing out of the Past Champion beyond 150 in 2020-21 FedExCup category, 2018 John Deere Classic winner **Michael Kim** (T2/-10) has hit 28 of 36 greens in regulation; making third start at this event (MC/2016, 74/2021)
- 2018 RBC Heritage winner **Satoshi Kodaira** (T2/-10) opens with rounds of 68-66; failed to break 70 in six previous rounds at the Puerto Rico Open
- Former University of Oklahoma standout and PGA TOUR rookie Max McGreevy (T2/-10) fires career-low 8-under 64 (previous best; 65/R2/2021 Butterfield Bermuda Championship); makes 11th PGA TOUR start and first at Puerto Rico Open; made three cuts in 10 prior starts with best result coming at The RSM Classic (T16); owns victories on PGA TOUR China Series (2019 Guangzhou Open) and Korn Ferry Tour (2020 Price Cutter Charity Championship)
- England's **Callum Tarren** (5th/-9) makes his 10th start of the season as a PGA TOUR rookie; after seven missed cuts and a DQ (Butterfield Bermuda Championship) in his first eight starts this season, comes into this week off a T30 at last week's Honda Classic
- Making his PGA TOUR debut, **Chris Gotterup** (T6/-8), one of three amateurs in the field, bogeys his 36th hole (No.18) en route to his second consecutive 68; the University of Oklahoma senior earned his way into this week's field by virtue of winning the Puerto Rico Classic collegiate event at Grand Reserve Golf Club two weeks ago after rounds of 66-64-66—196 (-20); last amateur to win on TOUR: Phil Mickelson/1991 Northern Telecom Open
- Official World Golf Rankings of players at 9-under or better: Ryan Brehm (773), Michael Kim (1030), Satoshi Kodaira (279), Max McGreevy (328), Callum Tarren (511)
- Chicago, Illinois native Patrick Flavin (T6/-8) reached 10-under before closing bogey-par-bogey (Nos. 16-18); makes third PGA TOUR appearance after Monday qualifying for each (MC/2020 WM Phoenix Open, T17/2021 Butterfield Bermuda Championship)
- Puerto Rico native **Rafa Campos** (T18/-6) played his last eight holes in 5-under to make the cut for the eighth time in 13 appearances at the Puerto Rico Open; seeks a fourth top-10 finish in the event (2016/T8, 2017/T10, 2021/T3)
- With an even-par 72, four-time PGA TOUR winner **Aaron Baddeley** (T24/-5) extends his streak of par-or-better scores at the Puerto Rico Open to a perfect 14-for-14
- **Kurt Kitayama** (T54/-2), who finished third at The Honda Classic last week, birdied four of his last five holes to improve on his opening-round 76 by 10 strokes
