Today – Rainfall overnight: 0.40”. Dry conditions are favored the rest of the morning with a small pocket of drier air moving overhead. An upper-level disturbance approaching the island and increasing moisture levels should lead to an uptick in shower coverage this afternoon. Heavy downpours are the main concern, but lightning also can’t be completely ruled out with weak instability developing. Brisk east/northeast winds can be expected with some gusts over 20 mph. Forecast Rainfall: Up to 0.25” with locally higher amounts. **Sunrise: 6:39am / Sunset: 6:30pm**

Extended forecast – An increasingly unsettled period of weather will begin to unfold tonight as an upper-level disturbance interacts with elevated moisture levels over the region. While the threat for showers will increase, confidence in the timing of the heaviest activity remains low. The most likely scenario would favor periods of showers late tonight through Sunday morning, followed by a potential lull during the afternoon. Showers would then quickly increase in coverage again Sunday night and persist into Monday. With increasingly instability, lightning can’t be ruled out, however heavy rainfall is the biggest concern.
