Today – Moisture levels will rapidly increase during the day with showers increasing in coverage and organization this afternoon. Heavy rain is a concern, especially if showers train over the same area for an extended time. Temperatures will climb into the middle 80s with east/northeast winds gusting 15-20 mph. Forecast rainfall: 0.15-0.40" with locally higher amounts likely. **Sunrise: 6:40am / Sunset: 6:29pm**

Extended forecast –Periods of showers, potentially heavy, will persist tonight with a gradual diminishing trend Friday morning as a pocket of drier air arrives. By Friday afternoon, only spotty shower activity is expected. The threat for showers appears to increase again on Saturday as an upper-level disturbance helps push another surge of moisture towards Puerto Rico. This disturbance is a relatively new development, however there is good enough agreement between model guidance to increase rain chances and amounts Saturday. Rain chances may need to be increased for Sunday as well once confidence improves.
