Today – There is a 10% risk for a passing shower this morning. Showers and thunderstorms will begin to develop around the noon hour, becoming a scattered coverage for much of the afternoon. The highest rain/storm chances are forecast to occur between 2-6pm before activity begins to decrease in coverage as daytime heating fades. The temperature will reach a high near 73°F/23°C. South-southwesterly winds will increase to 10-15 mph this afternoon.

Tomorrow – Rain will become likely overnight into tomorrow morning as an impulse of upper level energy moves into the region. There will be a threat of embedded thunderstorms within these areas of rain during the morning hours, with lightning probabilities of 30-40%. A relative lull in shower/embedded storm activity is anticipated from late morning into the early afternoon. Expect that scattered showers and thunderstorms will redevelop – especially between 2-4pm as a cold front passes overhead. Activity will wane in coverage/intensity after 5pm as the upper level impulse moves east, the cold front departs to the southeast, and instability from daytime heating fades.
Forecast rainfall: 0.25" – 0.50"/6.5-13mm **Sunrise: 5:36am / Sunset: 8:59pm**
