#### **TOURNAMENT STORYLINES**

**History at Heritage:** Eight-time PGA TOUR winner Stewart Cink is back in Hilton Head to defend his RBC Heritage title. With the win in 2021, Cink earned his third title at the RBC Heritage, 21 years and 2 days since his first victory in the event (2000). *Multiple Wins at RBC Heritage (\* in the field this week):*

Hoffmann returns: Morgan Hoffmann, who first joined the PGA TOUR in 2013, will return to competition for the first time since receiving the PGA TOUR Courage Award. In December 2017, Hoffmann announced that he had been diagnosed with facioscapulohumeral muscular dystrophy. He entered the 2018-19 season in the Major Medical Extension category with 18 starts available to earn 296.570 points and equal No. 125 (Seamus Power/377) on the 2017-18 FedExCup Regular Season points list. Hoffmann has used 15 of those 18 starts and earned 58.150 points, and will have three starts and 238.420 points remaining to stay in the Major Medical category for the remainder of the season.

#### **FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES**

No. 1: FedExCup leader and World No. 1 Scottie Scheffler earned his first major championship title and fourth win on the PGA TOUR in his last six starts at the Masters Tournament. Scheffler joined Tiger Woods as players to win four times in a PGA TOUR season, including a major and a World Golf Championships event. With his third TOUR victory at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play, Scheffler took over the No. 1 position in the Official World Golf Ranking on March 27 for the first time in his career. Scheffler is the 25th player to hold the World No. 1 title (est. 1986) and sixth-youngest. Scheffler also holds the lead in the FedExCup standings, becoming the first FedExCup leader to win on TOUR (outside of the TOUR Championship) since Justin Thomas at the 2020 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational.

**Youth movement:** On March 6 (and March 13), all of the top five in the Official World Golf Ranking were younger than 30 for the first time (est. 1986). This week, Cameron Smith enters the top five at the age of 28.

**Top players taking the title:** 12 of the 25 PGA TOUR events this season have been won by players who began the tournament in the top 25 of the Official World Golf Ranking, with the highest ranking by a winner this season at the Masters Tournament, where Scottie Scheffler became the first World No. 1 to win a TOUR event since Dustin Johnson at the 2020 Masters.

First-time winners: Nine players have earned their first PGA TOUR victory this season, including seven in the last 11 weeks. Most recently, J.J. Spaun won the Valero Texas Open, winning on TOUR for the first time in his 147th career start. 14 players have earned their maiden PGA TOUR victory at RBC Heritage Hale Irwin (1971), Graham Marsh (1977), Doug Tewell (1980), Nick Faldo (1984), Davis Love III (1987), Glen Day (1999), Jose Coceres (2001), Peter Lonard (2005), Aaron Baddeley (2006), Boo Weekley (2007), Branden Grace (2016), Wesley Bryan (2017), Satoshi Kodaira (2018), C.T. Pan (2019).

Winners way: There are 97 PGA TOUR winners scheduled to compete this week in Hilton Head, tied for second-most in an event this season (109/THE PLAYERS), highlighted by six players with double-digit TOUR wins: Dustin Johnson (24), Davis Love III (21), Jim Furyk (17), Justin Thomas (14), Zach Johnson (12) and Jordan Spieth (12).
