

Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Stewart Cink earned 500 FedExCup points with his 8th career PGA TOUR victory at the RBC Heritage

47 Stewart Cink records the sixth time since 1960 where a player 47 years and older have won multiple times in a season on TOUR. At 47 years 10 months and 28 days becomes the second oldest winner at the RBC Heritage behind Hale Irwin (1994) 48 years 10 months 14 days.

-19 Stewart Cink is just the fourth winner to finish at 19-under par or better at the RBC Heritage (2020 Webb Simpson -22, 2009 Brian Gay -20 & 1996 Loren Roberts -19)

2nd Stewart Cink became only the second RBC Heritage winner to average under par on par 3s since 2016

- 1st / 1,236** Scottie Scheffler extended his lead in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 to 1,236 after capturing his fourth TOUR title and first major at the 2022 Masters. His 1,236-point lead is the largest lead with 17 weeks left in the FedExCup regular season (under current points structure).
- 6th/29** Scheffler has led the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 in six weeks this season, marking the 29th player to lead the FedExCup standings for at least six weeks in their career
