**Today** – A complex of rain and thunderstorms is currently over the Atlanta area and moving to the east and southeast early this morning. This complex is expected to weaken as it approaches the low country by midday/early afternoon. However, showers and a few thunderstorms will be possible between 1-5pm as remnants of this system moves through the area. Otherwise, mostly cloudy skies can be expected this morning with temperatures warming into the 70s.

**Sunday's forecast** – A low pressure system will develop along a stalled frontal boundary that will produce numerous showers and thunderstorms, especially during the afternoon into the evening. Rainfall could be heavy at times, especially with thunderstorms. Rain and isolated thunderstorms will continue Sunday night into Monday before the system pulls away late in the day.
