**Today** – High clouds will be streaming overhead today making for partly to mostly cloudy skies today as thunderstorms to the west weaken as they move eastward. Warm temperatures will continue with highs in the upper 70s before the sea breeze cools the temperatures into the low to mid 70s mid-afternoon. Otherwise, only a slight chance for a shower or thunderstorm is expected this evening before chances increase overnight as the cold front approaches from the west.

**Extended forecast** – A cold front will be moving through the area Friday morning with the chance for showers and isolated thunderstorms. The precipitation should come to an end by 8-9AM before drier conditions return as high pressure builds in briefly for the afternoon. The front will likely stall out close by on Saturday into Sunday keeping the chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms in the forecast each afternoon, before another front provides a good chance for showers and storms on Monday.
