### Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Cam Davis earned his first career PGA TOUR victory in his 71<sup>st</sup> TOUR start at the 2021 Rocket Mortgage Classic. Davis defeated Troy Merritt and Joaquin Niemann in a five-hole playoff.
