Things to Know

- PGA TOUR rookie Sahith Theegala posts a bogey-free 5-under 67 to maintain his position at the top of the leaderboard for a third straight round; has made 17 birdies, one eagle and one bogey through 54 holes
- Seeking his first career PGA TOUR title in his 311th start, Cameron Tringale ties career-low score with a 10-under 62
- In search of his first career PGA TOUR title after a T6 in last year's Sanderson Farms Championship, Denny McCarthy posts a second-consecutive 7-under 65
- Second-year TOUR member (2018-19) Seth Reeves makes eight birdies and an eagle to post a career-low 9-under 63
- The Sanderson Farms Championship has produced a first-time winner six of the last seven seasons (Sergio Garcia/2020)
- Sam Burns, the highest-ranked player in the field (No. 25 OWGR), ties his career record with five consecutive birdies en route to a 7-under 65
- The Sanderson Farms Championship is the only event on the PGA TOUR where each of the last four 54-hole leaders/co-leader have converted for the win

- Third-round leader/co-leader to win Sanderson Farms Championship since the event moved to the Country Club of Jackson in 2014 (Ryan Armour/2017, Cameron Champ/2018, Sebastian Munoz/2019, Sergio Garcia/2020)

Sahith Theegala (1st/-18)

- Made five birdies, including three-straight on Nos. 10-12 to post a second-consecutive 5-under 67 and remain at the top of the leaderboard for the third-consecutive round; lone bogey thru 54 holes came on the par-5 fifth in round two
- With a win Sunday, would become the first first-time winner on the PGA TOUR since Erik van Rooyen at the 2021 Barracuda Championship

- PGA TOUR rookie earned his TOUR card following top-6 finishes in his last two starts in the 2021 Korn Ferry Tour Finals (T4/Nationwide Children's Hospital Championship, 6th/Korn Ferry Tour Championship presented by United Leasing & Finance)
- Prior to this week, his best position after any round on TOUR was T8/2017 The Genesis Invitational (finished T49)
- California native is making his 15th start on TOUR and comes off a T47 at the Fortinet Championship two weeks ago
- In only previous start at the Sanderson Farms Championship, missed the cut in 2020 (71-72—143)
- Named National Player of the Year his final season at Pepperdine University (2020 graduate)

Sam Burns (T2/-17)

- Highest ranked player in the field (No. 25 OWGR) tied his career-best with five consecutive birdies (Nos. 10-14) en route to a bogey-free 7-under 65
- Making his first start of the season, hit 10-of-14 fairways and 17-of-18 greens in regulation in round three; leads the field in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (7.241)
- Making his fifth Sanderson Farms Championship start; MC/2020, T45/2019, T3/2018, T43/2017
- Highlight of eight top-10 finishes last season was his first career PGA TOUR victory at the Valspar Championship; in his first start after the win outside Tampa, finished second at the AT&T Byron Nelson
- At No. 10 in the FedExCup after the BMW Championship, advanced to the season-ending TOUR Championship for the first time; finished T18 at East Lake to end his season at No. 18 in the FedExCup

Miscellaneous Notes

- In search of his first career PGA TOUR title in his 311th start this week, **Cameron Tringale** (T2/-17) made six birdies and two eagles (par-5 5th, par-5 14th) to post a 10-under 62, tying his career-low score from round four of The RSM Classic in 2020 (3rd); needed 23 putts to sink at total of 129' 4" of total putts; best of five previous starts at the Sanderson Farms Championship was T11 in his first start of 2010 (Annandale Golf Club)
- Coming off a T6 in the 2020 Sanderson Farms Championship, **Denny McCarthy** (T2/-17) made seven birdies and no bogeys, good for a second-consecutive 7-under 65; has now posted 16 consecutive sub-par scores at the Country Club of Jackson; also finished inside the top-10 in the 2018 event (T7)
- PGA TOUR rookie **Cameron Young** (T2/-17) offset two early bogeys with seven birdies to post a 5-under 67; this week's Sanderson Farms Championship marks his first made cut in five career starts on TOUR; two-time winner on the Korn Ferry TOUR (2020 AdventHealth Championship, 2020 Evans Scholars Invitational presented by First Midwest Bank)
- Second-year PGA TOUR member (2018-19) **Seth Reeves** (T6/-16) followed birdies on four of his first five holes with an eagle at the par-5 11th and additional birdies at Nos. 12, 13, 15 and 18 to post a career-low 9-under 63; needed just 23 strokes with the putter to sink 127′ 5″ of total putts; lone top-10 finish in 27 TOUR starts before this week was a T7 at the 2018 Sanderson Farms Championship
- Highlighted by six birdies and an eagle at the par-5 fifth, Alabama native **Trey Mullinax** posted a bogey-free 8-under 64 to move to T6 at 16-under 200; best finish in 83 previous TOUR starts was T2/2018 Valero Texas Open
- Using a one-time career earnings exemption for the 2021-22 season (top 50), 36-hole co-leader **Nick Watney** (T10/-14) posted a 1-under 71 in his bid for a fifth career TOUR title and first since THE NORTHERN TRUST in 2012
- One round removed from posting a career-low 11-under 61 and tying the Sanderson Farms Championship 18-hole scoring record, 2020-21 PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year **Will Zalatoris** could manage no better than an even-par 72; in only previous start at the Sanderson Farms Championship, missed the cut in 2020 (73-71—144)
