



- 3** Defending champion Sergio Garcia was one of three players in their 40s to pick up a victory in the fall events last season
- 29** Sebastian Munoz has made 29 putts from over 10 feet at the Country Club of Jackson, marking his second-most putts made on any course in his TOUR career (Sedgefield CC/32)
- 44** Peter Malnati is 44-under par at the Country Club of Jackson, best of any player since 2014
- 15' 11"** Last season, Brandt Snedeker was one of two players who averaged under 16' 0" in proximity to the hole on approaches from 75 to 125 yards. 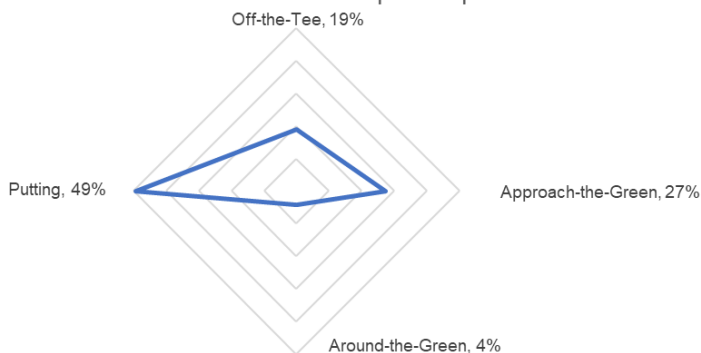

### Chesson Hadley
