- Designed by Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw
- Opened in 1991
- USGA Ratings – 75.5/140 from Championship Tees, 77.0/144 from Tour Tees
- Course Record 62 by K.J. Choi in 2003, Graeme McDowell in 2011, Jason Day and Chris Kirk in 2015, and Xander Schauffele in 2019 at the Tournament of Champions.
- Ocean and neighbor island views on every hole
- Host of the Sentry Tournament of Champions every January
- Plantation Course Refinement, 2019- Original Plantation Course architects Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw oversaw the refinement project along with Troon’s Design, Development and Agronomy team and Golf Channel personality Mark Rolfing. During the 9-month project all 107 acres of fairways, tees and rough were grassed with Celebration Bermuda grass, while all greens were grassed with TifEagle Bermuda grass. A capillary concrete liner system was installed in all 93 course bunkers, allowing the bunkers to better weather heavy rain events. The Plantation Course’s practice green and chipping green areas were also rebuilt, with TifEagle Bermuda grass added. The practice range tee area was laser leveled and grassed with Celebration Bermuda grass.

Summary: Kapalua

Beach Activities

Far from any urban center, the waters are crystal clear underwater parks beckoning beach lovers and local marine life year-round. A myriad of water sports activities are offered at Kapalua Bay and D.T. Fleming Beach, including diving, snorkeling, kayaking, boogie boarding, and more.
- Just north of Kapalua, the state Marine Life Conservation District of Honolua and Mokuleia Bays offer stunning underwater parks easily accessible to snorkelers and divers. These aquatic gardens harbor remnants of old lava flows, beautiful coral formations and abundant marine life including manini (mah-nee-nee), a hole hole (ah-hoh'-ley-hoh'-ley), uhu (oo'-hoo), octopus, damsel fish, Moorish idols, and Hawaii's official state fish (with a name almost longer than its length) the humuhumunukunukuapua'a (hoo-moo-hoo-moo-noo-koo-noo-koo-ah-poo-ah'-ah). The Honolua Bay is also a prime surfing spot in winter.

Kapalua Golf's Plantation Course Celebrates 30-Year Anniversary

2022 marks the 30th anniversary of Kapalua Golf's Plantation Course as the iconic Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw design first opened for play in 1992. Designed on a grand scale, the 7,596-yard, par 73 Plantation Course plays along the slopes of the West Maui Mountains boasting dramatic ocean views from virtually every hole.

The perennial Top 100 Course underwent a well-documented restoration in 2019 which focused on recapturing the essence and playing characteristics of the (then) nearly three decade-old course. During the 2019 restoration/refinement project, enhancements were made to the Plantation Course, including new bunkers; new Celebration Bermuda Turf on tees, fairways and roughs; and rebuilt and resurfaced green complexes. The overall Plantation Course layout and routing remained the same.



Throughout 2020 and 2021, additional projects have been completed to produce what Coore and Crenshaw originally planned during their 2019 refinement of the Plantation Course – namely to make the golf course firmer to get more ball roll. The drainage and top dressing projects, as well as enhanced maintenance practices, have “firmed-up” the golf course to where returning PGA TOUR professionals playing in the 2022 Sentry Tournament of Champions will certainly notice a difference in how the course plays – and how the ball rolls – compared to 2020 and 2021. Over the last 12 months, daily-fee guests playing the Plantation Course have experienced these firmer conditions as golf balls disappear then reappear among the contours of the fairways and greens, adding exciting moments to an already unforgettable round.

As Bill Coore explained following the 2019 refinement, “The top priority was to try to get the firmness and the bounce and the roll of the ball back into how the course played, certainly with tee shots, but far more importantly with the approach areas leading to the greens. We wanted golfers to have the ability to land the ball short of the green and allow it to bound onto the green, particularly on the long, downhill, downwind par-4s, like 1, 7 and 17.”

“The Plantation Course is a living, breathing organism that is changing every day, so our work to improve it will never be complete,” said Alex Nakajima, general manager, Kapalua Golf & Tennis. “Mahalo to Kapalua Golf's Director of Agronomy Andrew Rebman and his team for their incredible efforts in helping to make Mr. Coore and Mr. Crenshaw's vision for the Plantation Course a reality.”

Irrigation, drainage and maintenance projects completed on the Plantation Course in 2020 and 2021 include:

- The irrigation main line on the back nine was replaced and pressure regulator valves were upgraded.
- In 2020, 3.5 total miles of drainage pipe was installed on approaches on holes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18.
- In 2021, an additional half mile of drainage was installed behind 11 green and on the left side of No. 1 fairway.
- The drainage line on hole 6 was replaced with a new channel drainage, and new drainage was installed right of 17 tee.
- All approaches were top-dressed with 60 tons per acre of sand.
- Kapalua Golf's agronomy team has also increased cultural practices on greens via brushing
- 100 yards of cart path has been replaced.
- The nursery green was re-grassed with 14,000 sq. ft. of TifEagle Bermudagrass.

To commemorate the 30th anniversary of the Plantation Course, Kapalua Golf has commissioned famed artist Graeme Baxter to record its iconic 18th hole on canvas, with the painting being unveiled during the 2022 Sentry Tournament of Champions. The club is offering 30 limited-edition, 20 x 37 canvas giclées, which will be signed and numbered by the artist. Baxter has been official artist to some of the world's foremost golf tournaments, such as the Ryder Cup, the Open Championship, and the Presidents Cup, as well as artist to the PGA TOUR and European Tour. His work is displayed in clubhouses at St. Andrews, Augusta National and Pebble Beach. KAPALUA GOLF'S PLANTATION COURSE HOLE-BY-HOLE CHANGES (2019 Kapalua Refinement)

What does it mean to "refine and revitalize" a Top 100 golf course? The following is a detailed look at the enhancements made to Kapalua Golf's Plantation Course during the 9-month renovation project. Original Plantation Course architects Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw oversaw the project of the 28-year-old course along with Troon's Design, Development and Agronomy team and Golf Channel personality Mark Roling.

General changes on all 18 holes:

- All bunkers were rebuilt with new drainage, capillary concrete, reshaped, and new sand
- All greens were rebuilt including new drainage, new sand and grassed with TifEagle Bermuda grass
- All tees were laser leveled
- The entire course was replanted with Celebration Bermuda grass

Hole 1:

- Professional tee rebuilt and expanded
- Fairway bunkers moved in toward the fairway
- The green size expanded, making more hole locations available
- The bail out area right of the green has been re-established from native grass to Bermuda grass
- Native grass area added behind the fairway bunkers, left of 1 tees and right of 1 fairway

Hole 2:

- The green was expanded
- Small landform was placed front left of the green surround

Hole 3:

- New professional tee added
- Forward tees rebuilt and lowered
- First two fairway bunkers removed
- New fairway bunker added on the right side
- Greenside bunker bottoms raised and reduced in size
- Green was expanded by 1000 square feet
- Native grass area added to the right of the green

Hole 4:

- First left fairway bunker removed and first right fairway bunker reduced in size
- New professional tee and resort tee rebuilt and lowered
- The green was expanded making more hole locations available

Hole 5:

- New forward tee added
- New fairway bunker at 300 yards and a new approach bunker were added
- The green is slightly smaller
- The far right greenside bunker was removed
- The right greenside bunker bottom was raised 4 feet

Hole 6:

- The green expanded 900 square feet to the back and right side
- The green now has more pin location options

- Native grass area added behind the forward tee

Hole 7:

- New professional tee added to the right of the existing tee and the old professional tee was removed
- The resort and forward tee complex was rebuilt and lowered
- A new landform was added in the middle of the landing zone off the tee
- The bunkers were reduced in size
- The green was reduced in size by approximately 750 square feet

Hole 8:

- Right side professional tee rebuilt and expanded
- Left side professional tee removed
- Forward tee raised 3 feet
- Entire green complex was rebuilt
- All bunkers moved slightly closer to the green
- Front bunker bottom raised by 4-5 feet
- Bailout areas created left and right to capture errant shots

Hole 9:

- New professional tee added
- Tee complex rebuilt and lowered
- A new forward tee added
- A new landform in the left rough/fairway landing area
- Left fairway bunkers moved-in toward the fairway

Hole 10:

- New professional tee added
- New native grass areas established in front of professional tee and back left of the green complex
- The front left approach area was raised slightly to prevent balls from rolling off into the native area
- The green was softened and has many more pin locations available
- The green is smaller by approximately 500 square feet

Hole 11:

- The green expanded by approximately 500 square feet

Hole 12:

- New native grass areas established right of the right fairway bunkers and behind the green complex
- All fairway bunkers were move slightly in toward the fairway
- The front left approach bunker was reduced in size

Hole 13:

- Native grass was established left of the fairway narrowing the hole off of the tee by 60 feet
- A new forward tee was added
- The collection area past the fairway bunker was raised
- The approach was raised and softened
- The green was reduced in size by 1000 square feet
- More hole location options were added
- Native grass was established behind the green complex

Hole 14:

- The forward tee was rebuilt and shifted forward and left
- The first fairway bunker was removed
- The green expanded by 1200 square feet
- There are more pin location options available

Hole 15:

- The entire tee complex was rebuilt, lowered, and one small tee was removed
- A new forward tee was added
- A new landform was added at the end of the first fairway
- A new landform was added in the approach area
- The bottom of the existing approach bunker was raised by 5 feet
- A new bunker was added behind the existing bunker
- Native grass was established on the right side of the first fairway slightly narrowing the hole off the tee by 6-10 feet
- The green was reduced in sized by 400 square feet

Hole 16:

- The first middle fairway bunker was removed
- The far left fairway bunker was removed
- A new landform was added on the left side of the fairway
- A new bunker was added at 280-300 yards in front of the existing approach bunker
- The front right greenside bunker was removed
- All of the greenside bunkers were reduced in size and moved closer to the green
- The green was reduced in size by 600 square feet
- More hole location options are now available
- Native grass was established on the left side of the hole, right of the green, and behind the green

Hole 17:

- The first fairway bunker was removed
- A new landform was added front right of the green in the approach area
- More hole location options are now available

Hole 18:

- The bunker bottoms were raised slightly
- A subtle landform was added front middle of the green in the approach
- The green expanded by 1200 square feet
- There are more hole location options now available

Practice areas:

- The putting green was reduced in size by 33 percent
- A new chipping green, practice bunker and chipping green fairway were created
- The practice range tee was leveled and re-grassed
- A new slab was poured on the practice range tee
