TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

Winners only: The 2021-22 PGA TOUR Season resumes at the Sentry Tournament of Championships following a six-week break. The tournament returns* to its traditional winners-only format in 2022, with a 38-player field made up of PGA TOUR winners from the 2021 calendar year (37 of 39) as well as 2020 Olympic gold medalist Xander Schauffele. *Players who qualified for the 2020 TOUR Championship were eligible to compete in 2021 (one-year exemption category).

The field includes reigning FedExCup Champion Patrick Cantlay (making season debut), World Nos. 1 and 2 Jon Rahm and Collin Morikawa, and FedExCup leader Talor Gooch. In addition, 2021 PGA Championship winner and 45-time PGA TOUR champion Phil Mickelson will make his first start in the Sentry Tournament of Champions since 2001 (T28).

Sentry as a springboard: Harris English won the 2021 Sentry Tournament of Champions, winning on the PGA TOUR for the first time since the 2013 World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba. English was one of 16 players that got into the field by qualifying for the 2020 TOUR Championship. English went on to win the Travelers Championship as well, becoming the fifth winner of the event in the last six years to win again later in the season. In addition, each of the last six champions is currently in the top 15 of the Official World Golf Ranking.

Going low on No. 5: The par-5 fifth hole at Kapalua was the easiest hole on the PGA TOUR last season relative to par, with an average score of 4.095 (-0.905) and had the lowest average score relative to par of any hole on TOUR since the 2005 FUNAI Classic at the Walt Disney World Resort (Par-5 7th, Palm GC, -0.944). For reference, 197 par 4s on TOUR during the 2020-21 season played harder than 4.095 strokes, and 22 have already this season. *Scoring breakdown in 2021: 15 eagles, 127 birdies, 22 pars, 3 bogies, 1 double bogey.*

FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

Last time out: Talor Gooch won The RSM Classic, earning his first career PGA TOUR victory in his 104th start. With three top-fives and two T11s in six starts this season, Gooch has earned 852 FedExCup points, more than he earned in any of his first four seasons on the PGA TOUR. Gooch's top results this season aside from the win have come at the Fortinet Championship (T4) and THE CJ CUP @ SUMMIT (T5).

FedExCup leader: With his win at The RSM Classic, Talor Gooch moved to No. 1 in the FedExCup standings for the first time in his career. Gooch is the third player to hold the No. 1 position this season (Max Homa/2 weeks, Sam Burns/7 weeks) and the 71st player all-time to be the FedExCup leader.

Top players taking the title: All nine winners during the fall portion of the PGA TOUR schedule entered the week inside the top 60 of the Official World Golf Ranking. The average OWGR position of winners in the fall was 31.8, more than 20 spots higher than the previous record since the TOUR went to a wraparound schedule in 2013-14 (53.2, 2013-14). In the fall of 2020, the average winner's OWGR position was 169.8.

PGA TOUR LIVE on ESPN+: The partnership between the PGA TOUR and ESPN+ begins at the 2022 Sentry Tournament of Champions, with the streaming service scheduled to feature expanded and extended PGA TOUR LIVE coverage from 35 tournaments through the FedExCup Playoffs. PGA TOUR LIVE on ESPN+ will cover the Sentry Tournament of Champions for the first time with Featured Groups coverage in the mornings, followed by Featured Holes in the afternoon. The inaugural season of PGA TOUR LIVE on ESPN+ will more than triple the total coverage - adding more than 3,200 new hours of live streaming available for a total of more than 4,300 exclusive hours.
