Things to Know

- Following an 8-under 65, Cameron Smith holds his third opening-round lead/co-lead on TOUR (0-for-2 to date)
- Smith holds one-stroke lead over reigning FedExCup champion Patrick Cantlay, World No. 1 Jon Rahm and four-time PGA TOUR winner Daniel Berger
- Harris English cards 73 in bid to become first player since Geoff Ogilvy (2010) to successfully defend title at the event
- FedExCup leader Talor Gooch posts 5-under 68 in tournament debut

- 0 First-round leaders/co-leaders to win on TOUR in 2021-22

Miscellaneous Notes

- Reigning FedExCup champion and PGA TOUR Player of the Year **Patrick Cantlay** (T2) posts 7-under 66 in season debut; as an amateur, played final six holes in a career-best 6-under, closing birdie-birdie-eagle-birdie-birdie-par (was 5-under in final six holes en route to a second-round 60 in the 2011 Travelers Championship)
- World No. 1 **Jon Rahm** (T2) records bogey-free 66; his 17th par-or-better score in as many rounds in the event
- **Daniel Berger** (T2) opens with a score of 7-under or better for the first time in his PGA TOUR career
- 1994 and 1998 Sentry Tournament of Champions winner **Phil Mickelson** (T25) posts 2-under 71 in first Kapalua start since 2001
- **Justin Thomas** (T36) cards opening-round 74, just his third over-par score in 25 rounds in the event (R2/R3/2018)
- Due to wet conditions, preferred lies were in effect for the first round
