**Things to Know**

- Cameron Smith equals the Sentry Tournament of Champions 36-hole record (129) and holds the second-round lead/co-lead for the second time in a PGA TOUR stroke-play event (0-for-1 to date)
- World No. 1 Jon Rahm will be paired with Smith in the final pairing after playing the first 36 holes without a bogey
- Smith and Rahm are among four International players in the top-6 on the leaderboard
- The second-round scoring average (67.816) was the lowest since the event moved to The Plantation Course in 1999

- 3 Second-round leaders/co-leaders to win on TOUR in 2021-22 (most recent: Talor Gooch/The RSM Classic)

- Sits at 20-under on Nos. 3-18, most in opening 36-holes at the tournament since the event moved to Maui in 1999
- Second career 36-hole lead/co-lead in a PGA TOUR stroke-play event (0-for-1 to date); also held the lead with teammate Jonas Blixt en route to victory at the 2017 Zurich Classic of New Orleans

**Miscellaneous Notes**

- World No. 1 **Jon Rahm** (T2) is bogey-free through 36 holes; his second round 66 represents his 18<sup>th</sup> par-or-better score in as many rounds in the event
- Four-time PGA TOUR winner **Daniel Berger** (T2) trails by three after matching 7-under 66s in the first two rounds
- Reigning FedExCup champion and PGA TOUR Player of the Year **Patrick Cantlay** (4<sup>th</sup>) trails by four in season debut
- Two-time Sentry Tournament of Champions winner **Justin Thomas** (T32) bounces back from a 1-over 74 with a 6-under 67
- Defending champion **Harris English** sits T36 at the midway point in bid to become first players since Geoff Ogilvy (2010) to successfully defend title at the event
- Due to wet conditions, preferred lies were in effect for the second round
