Things to Know

- At 26-under, Cameron Smith and Jon Rahm turn in the second-lowest opening 54-hole score to par in PGA TOUR history (Patrick Reed/27-under/2014 The American Express)
- Smith and Rahm set the Sentry Tournament of Champions 54-hole record at 26-under 193 (194/Ernie Els/2003)
- Smith and Rahm also shared the 54-hole lead at the 2021 FedEx St. Jude Championship (eventually won by Tony Finau in a playoff over Smith)
- Rahm and two-time Sentry Tournament of Champions winner Justin Thomas set the tournament record with matching 12-under 61s
- The third-round scoring average (67.711) was the lowest in a single round since the event moved to The Plantation Course in 1999

Cameron Smith (T1/-26)

- Second career 54-hole lead/co-lead in a PGA TOUR stroke-play event (0-for-1 to date; 2021 FedEx St. Jude Championship/2nd); also held the lead with teammate Jonas Blixt en route to winning the 2017 Zurich Classic of New Orleans
- At 193, sets his low 54-hole score on TOUR (194/2021 World Golf Championships-FedEx St. Jude Invitational)
- Three-time PGA TOUR winner: 2017 Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with Jonas Blixt), 2020 Sony Open in Hawaii, 2021 Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with Marc Leishman)

Jon Rahm (T1/-26)

- Established the tournament 18-hole scoring record with a 12-under 61 (set earlier in the day by Justin Thomas)
- Sixth career 54-hole lead/co-lead in a PGA TOUR stroke-play event; 1-for-4 to date converting to victory (2020 the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday; was forced to WD after the third round of the 2021 Memorial Tournament)
- Also held the lead with teammate Ryan Palmer on the way to victory in the 2019 Zurich Classic of New Orleans
- At 193, sets his low 54-hole score on TOUR (197/2021 FedEx St. Jude Championship)

- Six-time PGA TOUR winner: 2017 Farmers Insurance Open, 2018 The American Express, 2019 Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with Ryan Palmer), 2020 the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, 2020 BMW Championship, 2021 U.S. Open

Miscellaneous Notes

- In addition to Rahm, **Justin Thomas** (T8) also set the tournament record with a 12-under 61; previous record was 62, set on five occasions and most recently by Xander Schauffele (R4/2019); marked his fifth round of 61 or better (most on TOUR since 2015)
