Things to Know

- Making his 100th PGA TOUR start, Sungjae Im is bogey-free through the first 36 holes for the first time in his career
- Im posts his best opening 36-hole score on TOUR en route to his fourth 36-hole lead/co-lead
- PGA TOUR rookie Chad Ramey leads the field in Strokes Gained: Putting, Proximity to the Hole and Driving Accuracy (T1) and holds his first lead/co-lead after any round on the PGA TOUR
- Following a career-best 62, Aaron Wise is bogey-free through the first two rounds
- 2020 runner-up Matthew Wolff has now carded a score in the 60s in all 10 rounds he has played at the event
- First-round leader Sung Kang falls to T17 following a 2-over 73
- Among the notables missing the cut: Paul Casey, Rickie Fowler, Kevin Kisner, Ian Poulter, Patrick Reed, Will Zalatoris

- 8 Second-round leaders/co-leaders to win the Shriners Children's Open since it became a 72-hole event in 2004 (Most recent: Martin Laird/2020)

Sungjae Im (T1/-14)

- Making his 100th PGA TOUR start this week and in search of second win (2020 The Honda Classic)
- Is bogey-free through the first two rounds on TOUR for the first time in his career

- Holds the 36-hole lead/co-lead for the fourth time (2019 The Honda Classic/T51, 2019 Corales Puntacana Championship/T7, 2021 The American Express/T12, 2021 Shriners Children's Open/TBD)
- At 14-under 128, records his best opening 36-hole score on TOUR (129/2019 Wyndham Championship)
- Has top-15 finishes in both prior starts at the Shriners Children's Open (T13/2020, T15/2018)

Chad Ramey (T1/-14)

- PGA TOUR rookie holds his first lead/co-lead after any round on TOUR following a 6-under 65
- Leads the field through the first two rounds in Proximity to the Hole (27'3"), Strokes Gained: Putting (4.554) and Driving Accuracy (24 of 28; T1)
- Scoring breakdown: front nine (2-under), back nine (12-under)
- Finished T26 at the 2018 Sanderson Farms Championship for his best finish in four PGA TOUR starts
- After missing the cut in the season opener at the Fortinet Championship, finished T63 at the Sanderson Farms Championship
- Finished the 2020-21 combined season No. 4 in the Korn Ferry Tour points standings, highlighted by a win at the 2021 Live and Work in Maine Open

Sam Burns (T3/-13)

- Would become the first player to win in back-to-back weeks since Patrick Cantlay at the 2021 BMW Championship and TOUR Championship; the last player to win in back-to-back weeks in the FedExCup Regular Season was Brendon Todd in 2019 (Butterfield Bermuda Championship, World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba)
- Ties the second-lowest score of his TOUR career with a 63, one shy of a second-round 62 at the 2021 AT&T Byron Nelson
- Equals his second-lowest opening 36-hole score with a 13-under 129, second only to 127 at the 2021 AT&T Byron Nelson
- Making his fifth start at the Shriners Children's Open (T20/2017, MC/2018, MC/2019, T34/2020)

Matthew Wolff (T6/-11)

- Lost in a playoff at the 2020 Shriners Children's Open; the last player to win on TOUR after losing in a playoff at the same tournament the year prior was Ryuji Imada at the 2008 AT&T Classic (lost in a playoff in 2007 to Zach Johnson)
- Sixth consecutive under-par score on TOUR, his longest streak since R1/2020 PGA Championship through R2/2020 THE NORTHERN TRUST
- Has now carded a score in the 60s in all 10 rounds he has played at the Shriners Children's Open (scoring average: 66.10)

Miscellaneous Notes

- At 13-under 129, **Adam Schenk** (T3/-13) tops his best opening 36-hole score by two strokes (2021 John Deere Classic/131); finished fourth at the 2021 Barracuda Championship and T4 at the 2021 John Deere Classic for his best finishes in 118 PGA TOUR starts
- **Aaron Wise** (5th/-12) records his low round on TOUR with a 9-under 62; shot 63 on four prior occasions and most recently during the final round of the 2020 World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba
- TPC Summerlin member and former UNLV golfer **Harry Hall** (T6/-11) trails by three after rounds of 66-65; the winner of the Korn Ferry Tour's 2021 Wichita Open is playing this week on a sponsor exemption
- **Louis Oosthuizen** (T13/-10), the highest-ranked player in the field at No. 8 in the Official World Golf Ranking, is making his second start at the event (T19/2020)
- Following a first-round 10-under 61, first-round leader **Sung Kang** (T17/-8) turns in a 2-over 73
- Defending champion and two-time Shriners Children's Open winner **Martin Laird** (T30/-7) trails by seven following a second-round 3-under 68
- **Kelly Kraft** (neck injury), **Pat Perez** (foot injury) and **Seung-Yul Noh** (illness) withdrew during the second round
