Things to Know

- Sungjae Im picks up his second PGA TOUR victory in his 100th start; first win came in his 50th start (2020 Honda Classic)
- Im records the 20th win by a Korean on TOUR; final-round 9-under 62 included a career-best nine birdies
- At 24-under 260, Im ties Ryan Moore (2012) and Webb Simpson (2013) for the low winning score since TPC Summerlin moved to a par-71 layout in 2009
- Matthew Wolff finishes runner-up for the fourth time on TOUR, including the 2020 and 2021 Shriners Children's Open
- Adam Schenk falls to 0-for-2 when holding the 54-hole lead/co-lead
- Defending champion Martin Laird finishes T11; Jim Furyk (1998-99) remains the only back-to-back winner of the event

- Earns his second PGA TOUR victory at the age of 23 years, 6 months, 10 days; second-youngest winner of the event behind 1996 champion Tiger Woods (20 years, 9 months, 6 days)
- Has victories in his 50th (2020 Honda Classic) and 100th (2021 Shriners Children's Open) PGA TOUR starts
- Collects 500 points and moves from T59 to No. 2 in the FedExCup standings; has reached the TOUR Championship in each of his first three seasons on TOUR (19th/2019, 11th/2020, 20th/2021)
- Picks up the 20th victory among the eight different Koreans who have won on TOUR (Note: does not include those of Korean descent who play under different flags)
- At 24-under 260, ties Ryan Moore (2012) and Webb Simpson (2013) for the event's low winning score since TPC Summerlin moved to par-71 layout in 2009
- Final-round 62 includes career-high nine birdies and equals career-low round (2019 Wyndham Championship/R1)
- Prior to Im, the last PGA TOUR winner to shoot 62 or better in the final round was Brendon Todd at the 2019 Butterfield Bermuda Championship

- Four-stroke winning margin is the largest on TOUR since Stewart Cink's four-stroke victory at the 2021 RBC Heritage
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (10.488), Sand Saves (5 of 5) and Scrambling (9 of 10)
- Has finished inside the top 15 in all three Shriners Children's Open starts (T15/2018, T13/2020, 1st/2021)

Miscellaneous Notes

- **Matthew Wolff** (2nd) finishes runner-up for the fourth time on TOUR, including a playoff loss to Martin Laird at the 2020 Shriners Children's Open; the last player to finish runner-up twice in a row at the same event was Charley Hoffman (2019, 2021 Valero Texas Open; Note: the 2020 Valero Texas Open was canceled due to the pandemic); final-round 68 marks his eighth consecutive under-par score on TOUR, the longest streak of his career
- **Adam Schenk** (T3) falls to 0-for-2 when holding the 54-hole lead/co-lead (2021 Barracuda Championship/4th); had posted 12 straight rounds in the 60s at the Shriners Children's Open prior to final round 1-under 70
- Following a T4 at the Fortinet Championship in his season debut, **Marc Leishman** (T3) records back-to-back top-10 finishes in individual stroke-play starts for the first time since 2019 (Sentry Tournament of Champions/T4, Sony Open in Hawaii/T3)
- Olympic silver medalist **Rory Sabbatini** (T3) opens with a career-low 28 en route to a final-round 7-under 64; best finish on TOUR since T3 at the 2019 Rocket Mortgage Classic
- PGA TOUR rookie **Hayden Buckley** has finished inside the top 10 in his last two starts (T4/Sanderson Farms Championship, T8/Shriners Children's Open)
- TPC Summerlin member and former UNLV golfer **Harry Hall**, playing on a sponsor exemption, earns a spot in the Butterfield Bermuda Championship with his T8 finish
- Two-time Shriners Children's Open winner and defending champion **Martin Laird** finishes T11; Jim Furyk (1998-99) remains the only player to win the Shriners Children's Open in back-to-back years
- Last week's Sanderson Farms Championship winner **Sam Burns** finishes T14 in attempt to become the first player to win his first two starts of a season since Tiger Woods in 2008
