

**2022 Sony Open in Hawaii  
Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes**



- 67.61** Harris English has the seventh-best Opening two round Scoring Average of players with six or more Sony Open appearances (67.61)
- 61** Billy Horschel is 61 under in his last five TOUR starts in the state of Hawaii, 33 strokes better than in his first five starts in Hawaii (-28)
- 71.43%** Since the start of last season, Abraham Ancer has the fifth-best Driving Accuracy percentage of players with 35 or more rounds. Ancer has hit 71.43% of his fairways in this time frame.
- 5.0** Webb Simpson has the best Birdie Average at the Sony Open in Hawaii since 2013 (*min 12 rds*)
- 5** Kevin Kisner has five rounds of 64 or better at the Sony Open in Hawaii, marks his most in a TOUR event
- 8** Hideki Matsuyama is tied with Patrick Reed for the second-longest active streak qualifying for the TOUR Championship (Dustin Johnson/13, Reed & Matsuyama/8)
- 23** Coming off his record setting weekend performance of 23-under par at last week's Sentry Tournament of Champions, Matt Jones is set to make his 10<sup>th</sup> start at the Sony Open in Hawaii.
- 7** Sungjae Im has seven top-20 finishes in his last eight TOUR starts, t-most of any player since start of 2021 FedExCup Playoffs (Sam Burns)
- 12** Marc Leishman has the third-longest active cuts made streak among active players at the Sony Open in Hawaii (Charles Howell III/20, Tom Lehman/17)
- 27** FedExCup leader Talor Gooch is set to make his fifth start at the Sony Open in Hawaii and leads the TOUR since the start of last season with 27 hole-outs
- 34 / 6 / 1<sup>st</sup>** Cameron Smith set the PGA TOUR record for most under par in a 72-hole event (since 1950) finishing the 2022 Sentry TOC at 34 under. Smith became the sixth player to complete the Hawaii slam, winning both the Sentry Tournament of Champions (2022) and the Sony Open in Hawaii (2020) and joined Bryson DeChambeau (2020 Rocket Mortgage Classic) as the only two winners to rank first in both SG: Off-the-Tee and Putting en route to victory on TOUR since 2004
- 14** Kevin Na played the back 9 at Waialae CC in 14 under for the week, marking his best Back 9 Score to Par in an event on TOUR

**FedExCup Storylines**

- 11** Since 2007, 11 of the 15 Sony Open in Hawaii champions have qualified for the TOUR Championship, finishing inside the top 30 in the final FedExCup standings that season
- 3<sup>rd</sup>** 2021 champion Kevin Na finished Third in the final FedExCup standings last season, marking his career best finish in the FedExCup
- 1,281** Since 2009, no player has earned more FedExCup season points at the Sony Open in Hawaii than Jimmy Walker. Walker has earned 1,281 FEC points in this timeframe including two victories in 2014 & 2015.
- 60%** Through the Sentry TOC, the FedExCup leader has finished the FedExCup Regular season in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 three of the last five seasons (60%)
- 2** Jason Kokrak is one of two players (Viktor Hovland) who have ranked in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 in each of the last two seasons
